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
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Introduction

Headline consumer price inflation in January 2015 continued to decline with the negative level for four months consecutively. During this period, Cambodian Riel (KHR) appreciated against US dollar whereas bank services continued to improve reflected by the increases in credit to private sector and deposits. At the same time, the international trade in goods showed a decrease in deficit.

Consumer Price Index


The consumer price index inflation in Phnom Penh (month-on-month) continued to decline to a negative level of 0.43% in January 2015 from the negative level of 0.74% in December 2014. In which, four out of twelve group indexes decreased while seven group indexes increased, and the other group index remained stable.



During the same period, the year-on-year percentage change of the CPI for all items continued to ease to 0.41% in January 2015 from 1.07% in December 2014, mainly due to a decrease in oil price.


Exchange Rate

The exchange rate (market buying rate) was KHR 4,059 per US dollar in January 2015, appreciated by 0.12%, compared to the previous month. This was due to the increase in demand for KHR for tax payment purpose and expense during the national holiday.




Money Supply

Broad money (M2) continued to increase to KHR 43,494.9 billion in January 2015, up 2.2% compared to December 2014. The components contributing to the increase of M2 were: growths of time and saving deposits (9.9%), currency outside banks (5.7%), and resident's foreign currency deposits (1.6%) while demand deposits decline (5.8%).



Net Domestic Assets of the Banking Sector


Net domestic assets of the banking sector in January 2015 continued to increase to KHR 16,677.7 billion, up 5.2% from the previous month, of which domestic credit increased 2%.



The increase in domestic credit was reflected by an increase of 0.9% in credit to private sectors and 7.1% in net claims on government.


Net Foreign Assets of the Banking Sector

Net foreign assets of the banking sector increased to KHR 26,817.3 billion in January 2015, up by 0.4% from December 2014, mainly due to an increase of 2.9% in total foreign assets.




Deposit Money Banks' Operations

Total assets of commercial banks and specialized banks were KHR 68,475.1 billion, up 3.2% in January 2015 from the previous month.




Foreign Tourist Arrivals

In January 2015, the total number of passenger arrivals was 460,577 passengers, down by 8% after increasing 21.6% last month. The main purpose of the passenger arrivals in Cambodia was for vacation, accounting for more than 91% of the total.



Most of the foreign passengers were from Vietnam, South Korea, China P.R.C., Lao PDR, United States of America, Thailand, Japan, Australia, France, and United Kingdom.



International Trade in Goods

International trade in goods showed a deficit of KHR 401.9 billion (12.6%) in January 2015, from the deficit of KHR 1,294 billion (35.8%) in December 2014.



The major components of total exports were Garment, Footwear, Rubber, Sawn Timber, and Textile. And the major components of total imports were Petroleum, Vehicles, Cigarettes, Motor Bikes, Steel, Construction Materials, Gold, Cement, Clothing, Beer, and Sugar.







(At Constant 2000 Prices)





Chart 4: GDP by Economic Activity





Chart 8: Monetary Survey




Chart 9: Components of Money Supply





(Share of Grand Total Deposits)



(Share of Total KHR Deposits)





Chart 13: Deposits in Foreign Currency Classified by Type, as of January 2015
