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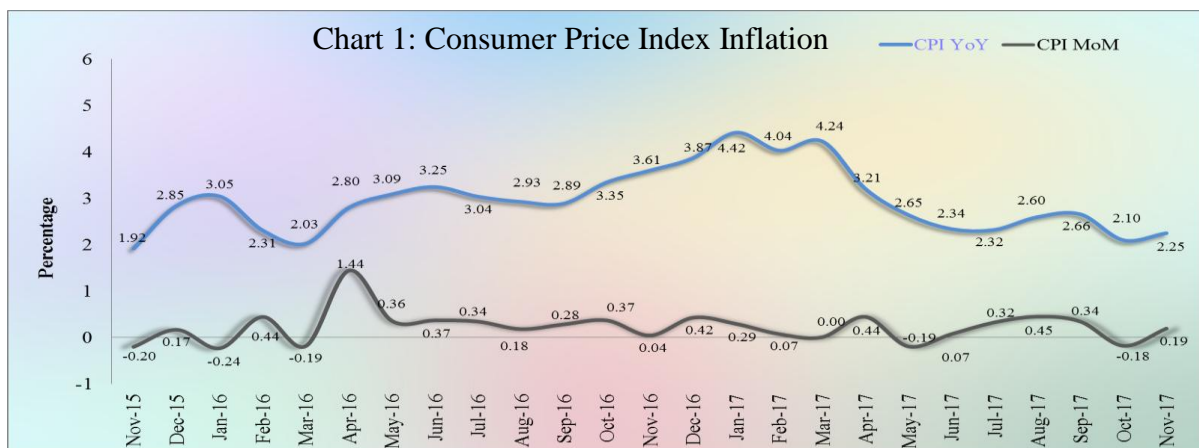
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## Introduction

Headline consumer price inflation in November 2017 accelerated compared to a month earlier. During this period, Cambodian Riel (KHR) appreciated against US dollar, whereas financial intermediation of the banking sector continued to increase. At the same time, the international trade in goods showed an increase in deficit.

## Consumer Price Index

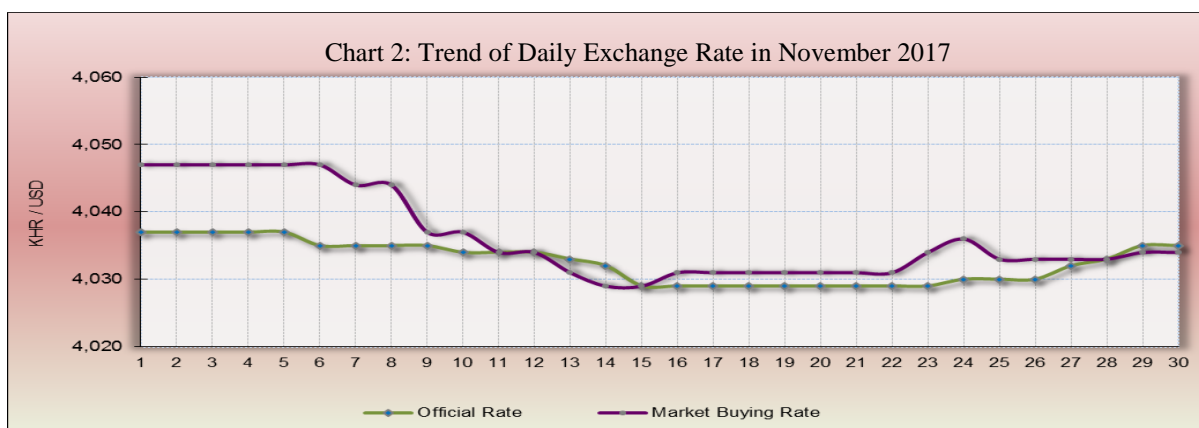
The consumer price inflation in Phnom Penh (month-on-month) accelerated to 0.19% in November 2017 after declining to the negative level of -0.18% in October. In which, four out of twelve group indexes increased while six group indexes decreased and the other two group indexes remained unchanged.



During the same period, the year-on-year percentage change of the CPI for all items increased to 2.3% in November 2017 from 2.1% in October, reflecting mainly by the increases in food and oil prices.

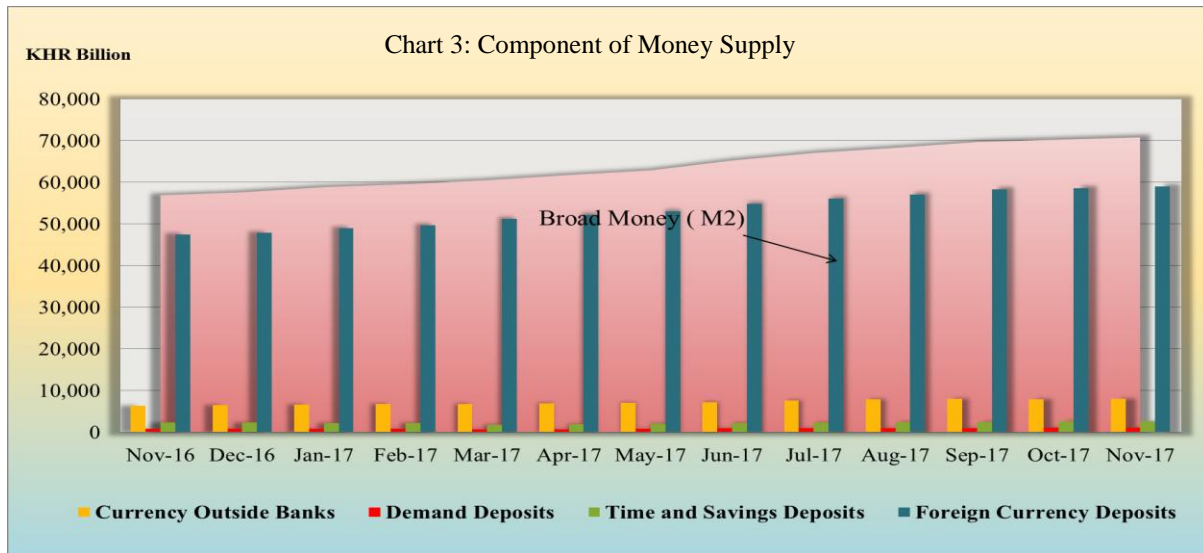
## Exchange Rate

The exchange rate (market buying rate) was KHR 4,034 per US dollar in November 2017, appreciated by 0.32%, compared to the previous month. This was mainly due to the increase in demand for KHR for tax payment purpose and for spending during water festival days.



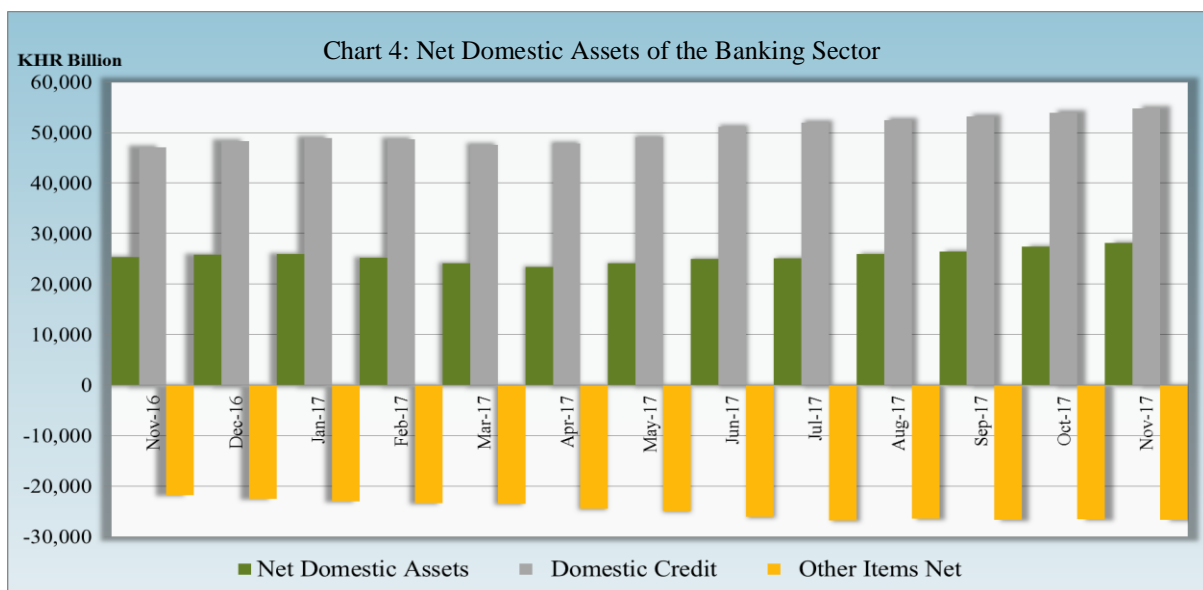
## Money Supply

Broad money (M2) increased to KHR 70,814.2 billion in November 2017, up 0.8% compared to October. The components of M2 including demand deposits, currency outside banks, resident's foreign currency deposits, and time and saving deposits increased by 2.5%, 1.4%, 0.7%, and 0.3%, respectively.



## Net Domestic Assets of the Banking Sector

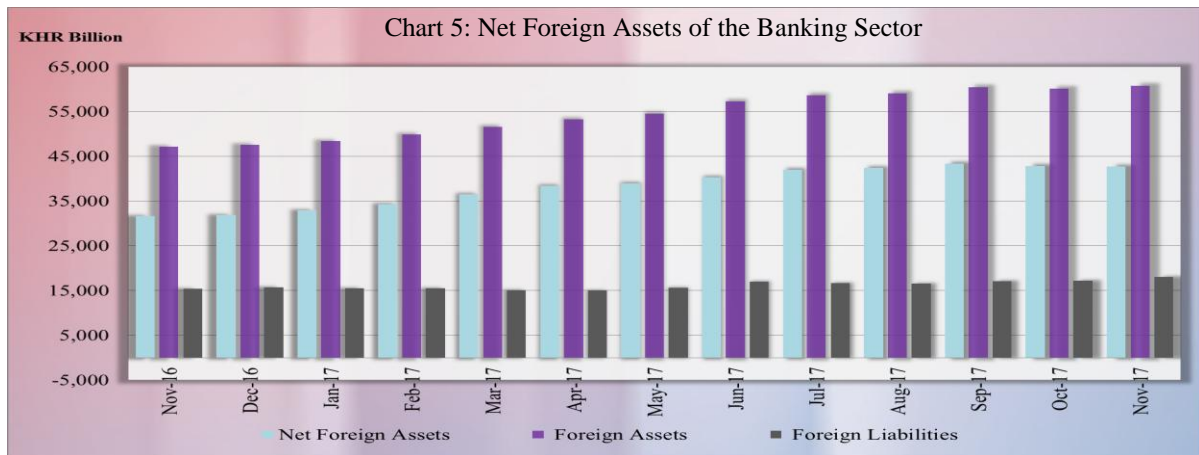
Net domestic assets of the banking sector continued to increase to KHR 28,141.3 billion in November 2017, up by 2.6% compared to the previous month. This was due to an increase of 1.5% in domestic credit while other items net declined by 0.4%.



The increase in domestic credit was reflected by an increase of 1.5% in credit to private sectors while net claims on government declined by 1.4%. The decrease in other items net was mainly due to an increase of 1.3% in in capital and reserves.

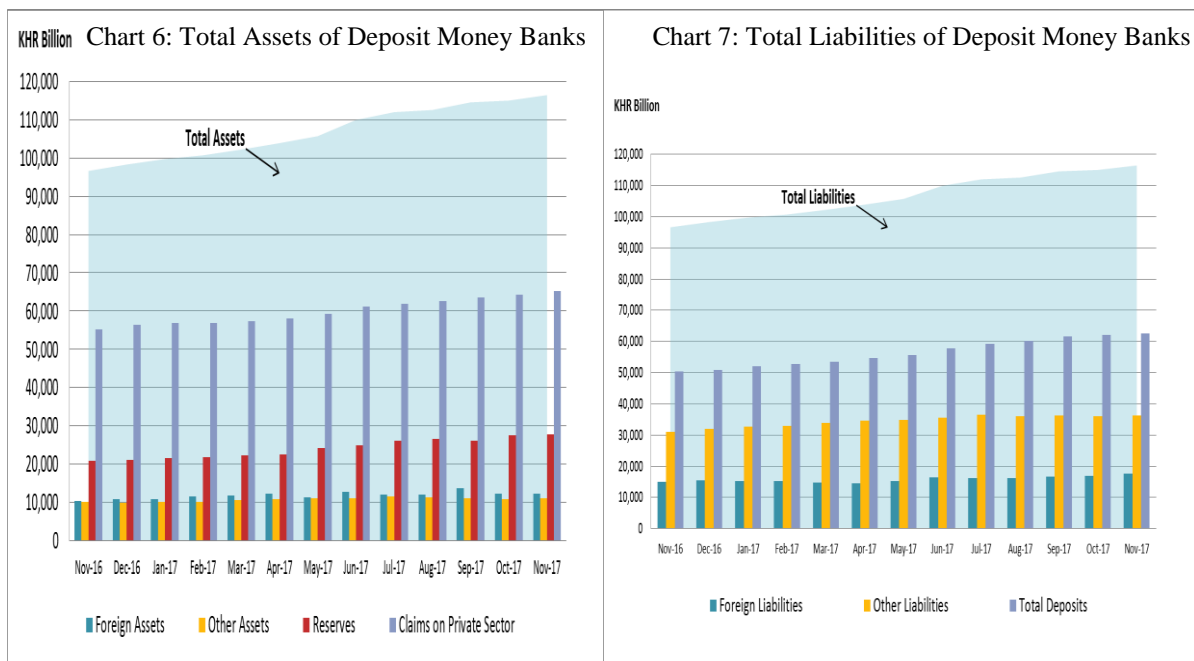
## Net Foreign Assets of the Banking Sector

Net foreign assets of the banking sector continued to decline two months consecutively to KHR 42,672.9 billion in November 2017, down by 0.4% from October. The decline was mainly due to an increase of 4.6% in total foreign liabilities while total foreign assets increased only 1.1%.



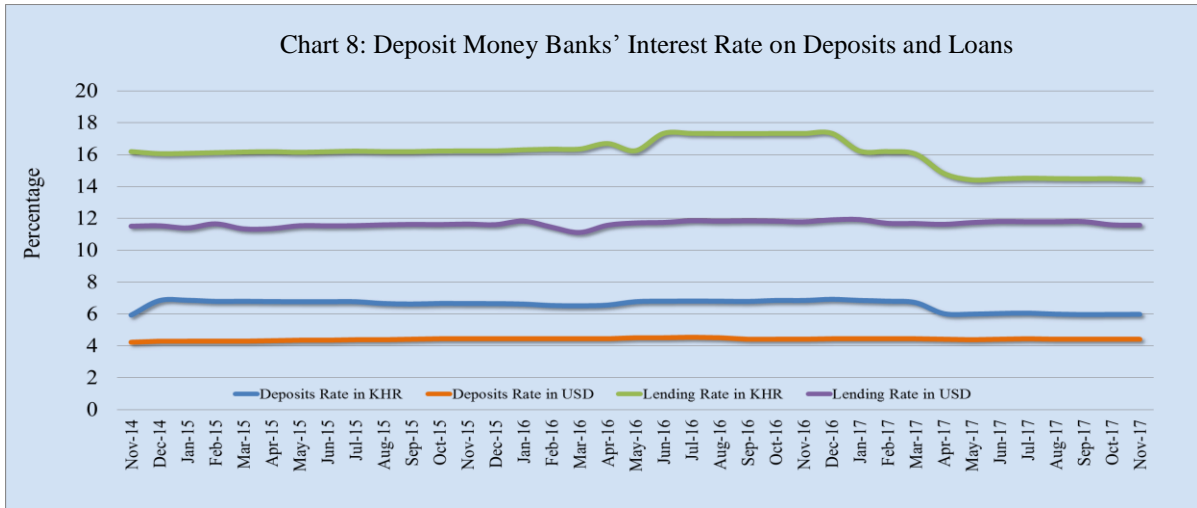
## Deposit Money Banks' Operations

Total assets of commercial banks and specialized banks were KHR 116,429.7 billion, up by 1.2% in November 2017 compared to the previous month.



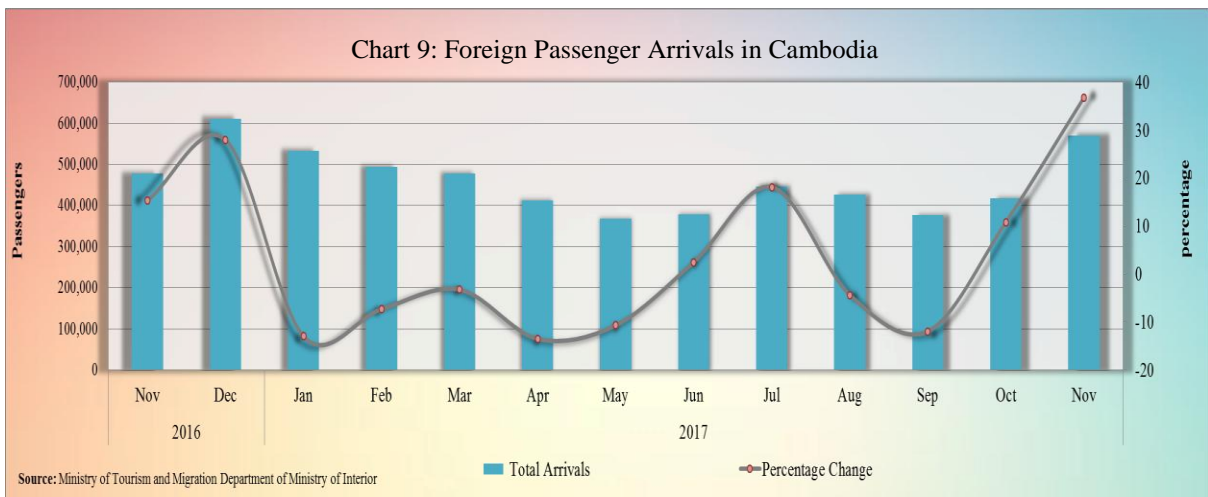
## Interest Rates on Loans and Deposits

In November 2017, the interest rate movement with a maturity of 12-month on deposits and loans showed that the weighted average deposit rate both in KHR and in US dollar increased by 0.01%. At the same time, the weighted average lending rate in KHR and US dollar decreased by 0.06% and 0.02%, respectively.



### Foreign Tourist Arrivals

In November 2017, the total number of passenger arrivals was 570,471 passengers, increased by 36.8% following the increase of 10.8% in the preceding month. The main purpose of the passenger arrivals in Cambodia was for vacation, accounting for 91% of the total.



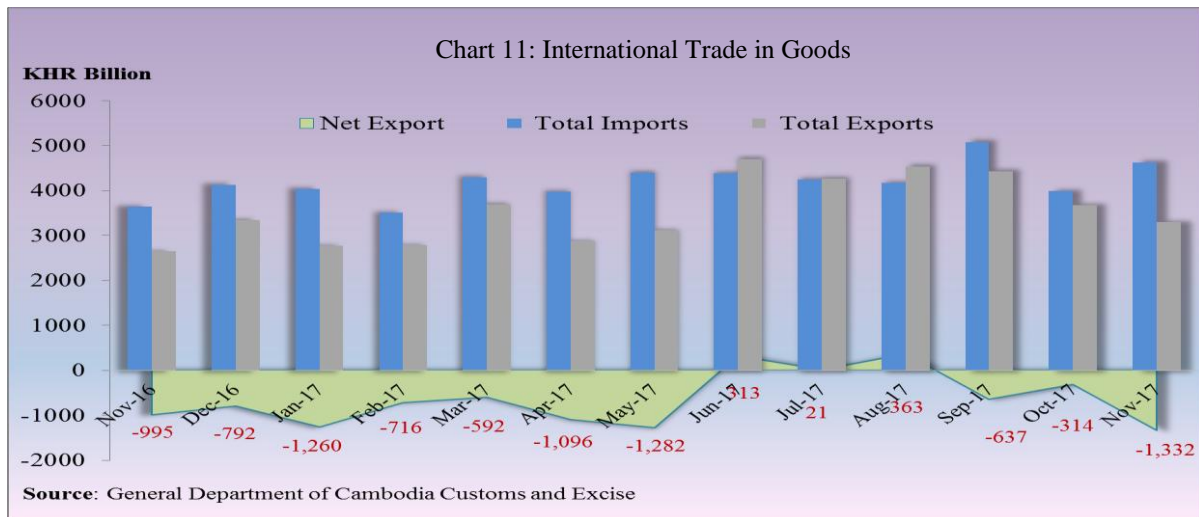
Most of the foreign passengers were from China P.R.C., Vietnam, Lao PDR, Thailand, South Korea, United States of America, Japan, Malaysia, France, and United Kingdom.



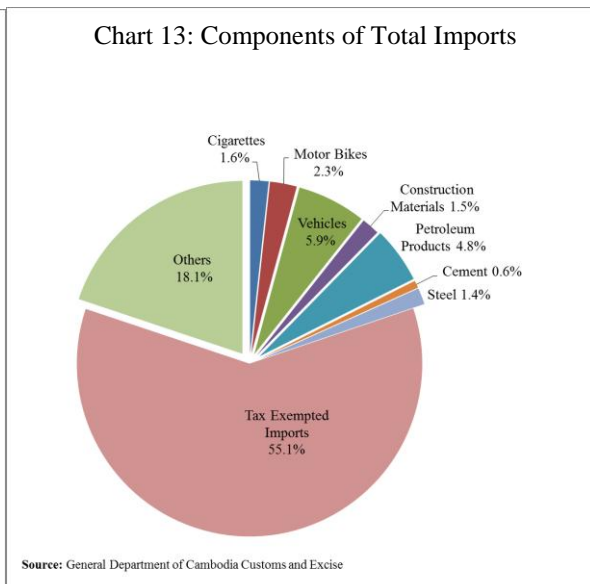
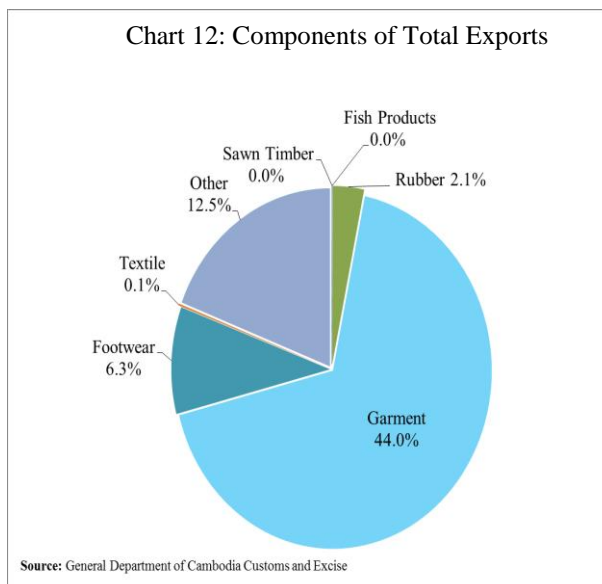


## International Trade in Goods

International trade in goods showed a deficit of KHR 1,331.8 billion (28.8%) in November 2017, following the deficit of KHR 314.2 billion (7.9%) in October 2017.



The major components of total exports were Garment, Footwear, Rubber, Textile, and Sawn Timber. And the major components of total imports were Vehicles, Petroleum, Motor Bikes, Cigarettes, Construction Materials, Steel, Gold, Clothing, Cement, Beer, Cloths, and Sugar.

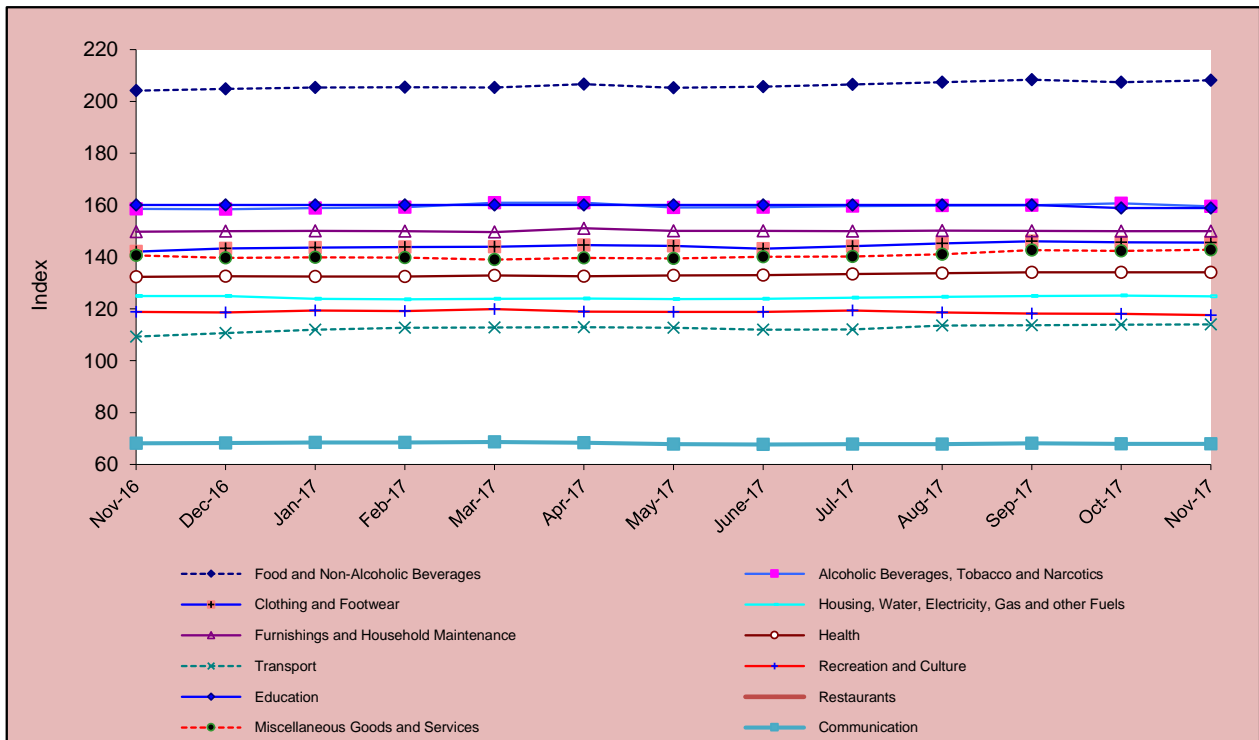

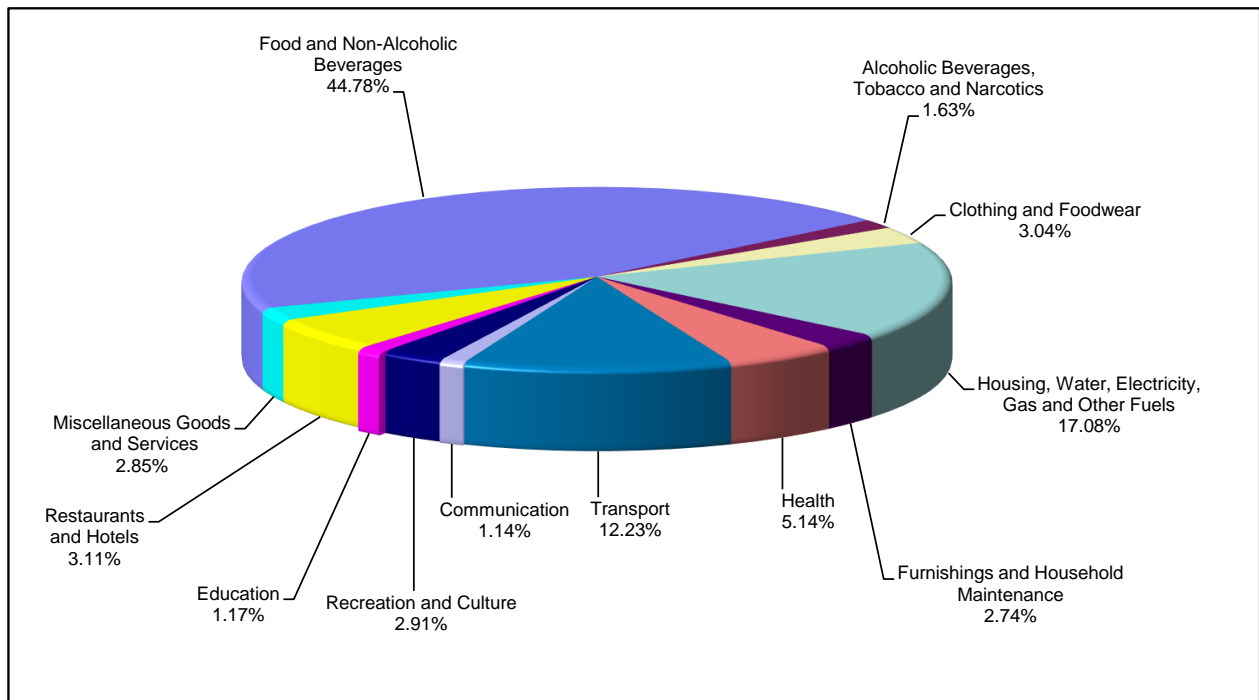

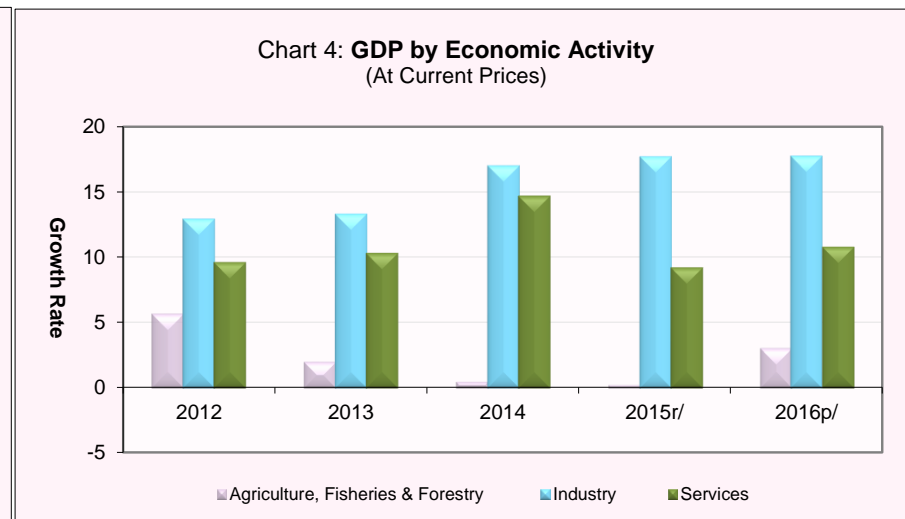
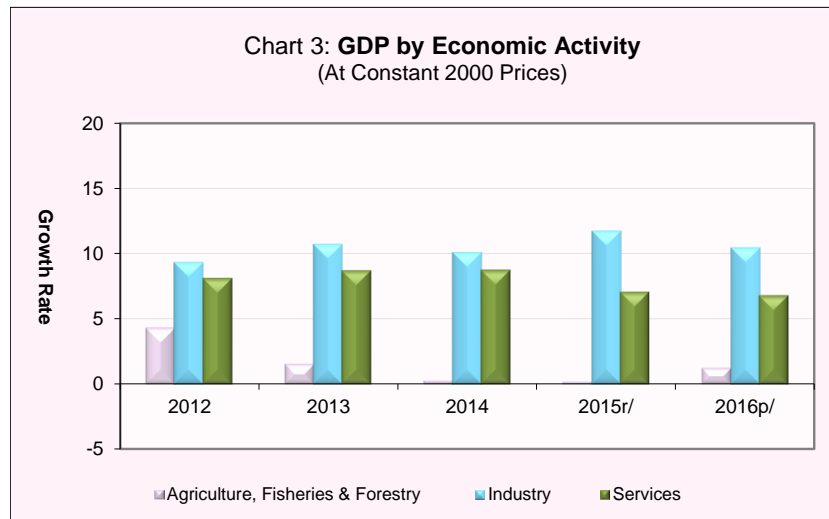
**Chart 2: Weight of All Group Indices in Consumer Basket**

Chart 5: Investment Fixed Assets by Sectors

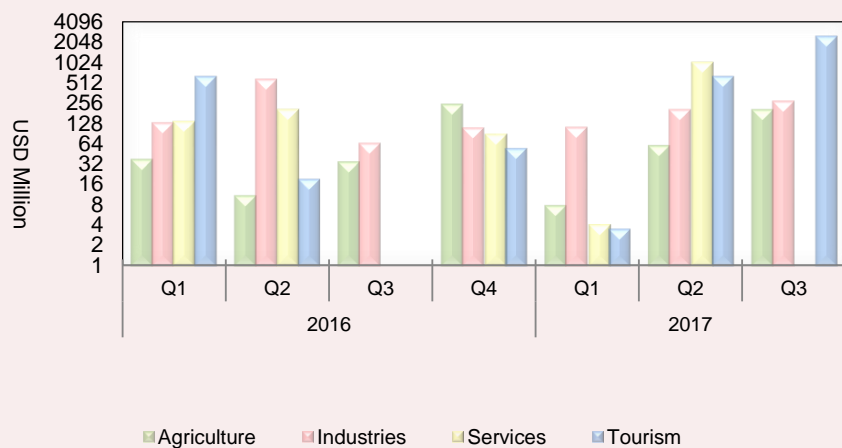
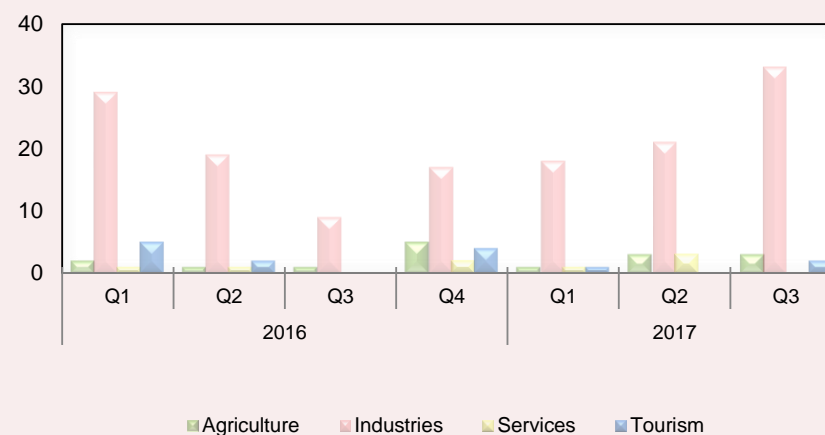


Chart 6: Number of Investment Projects by Sectors

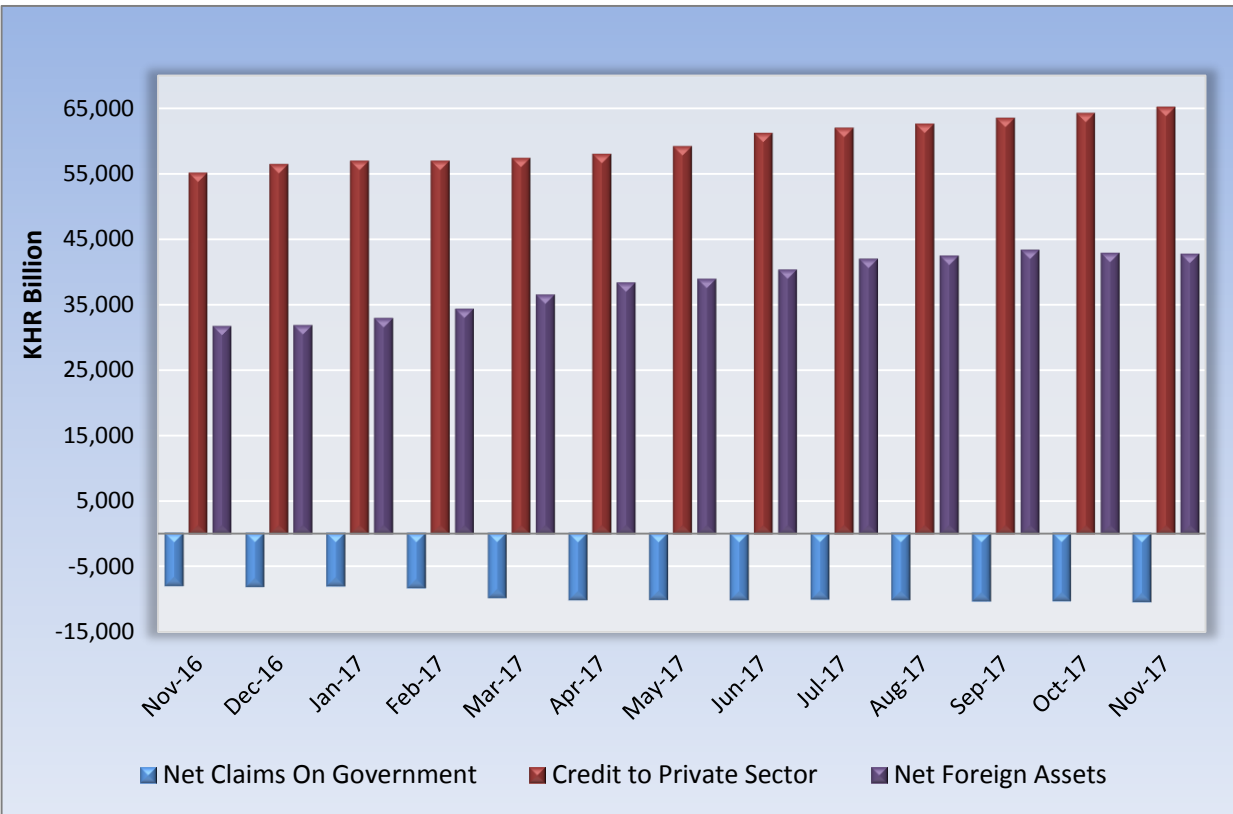

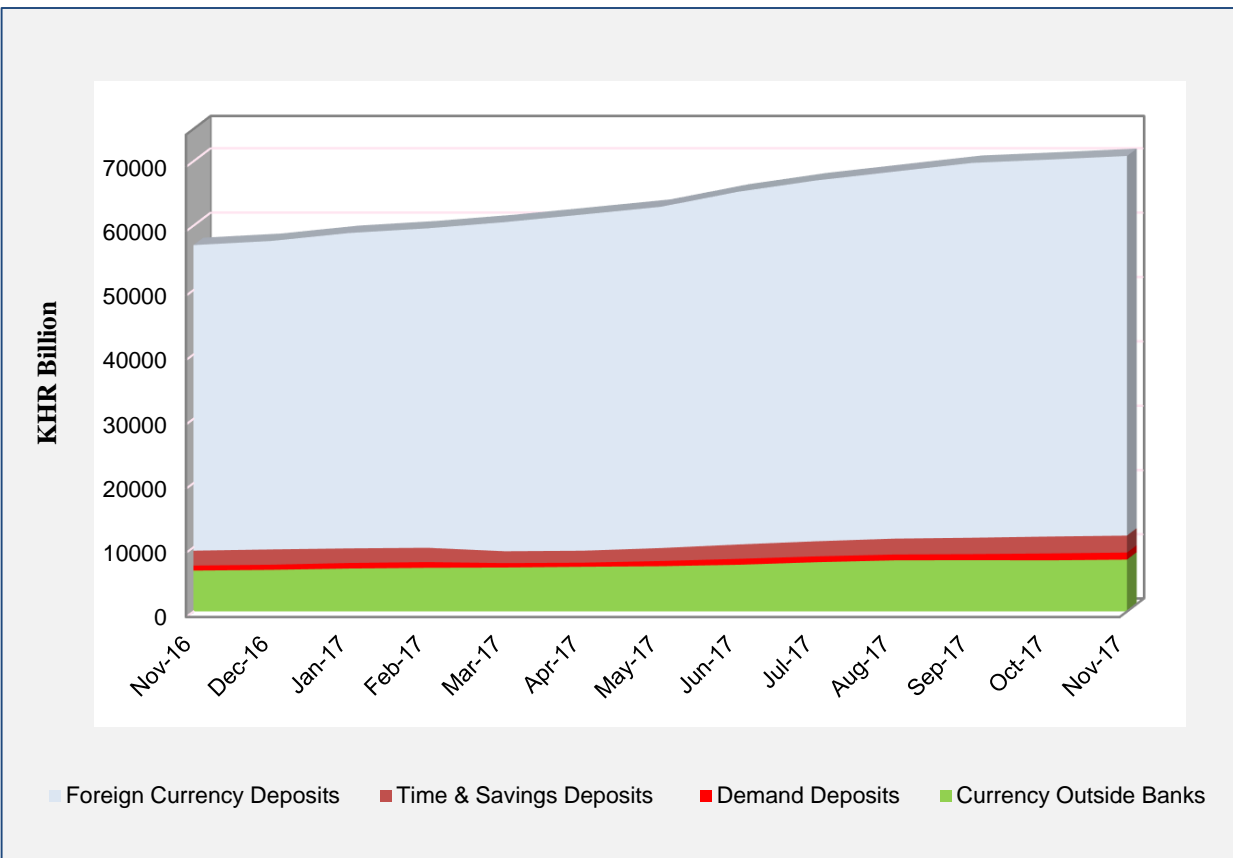

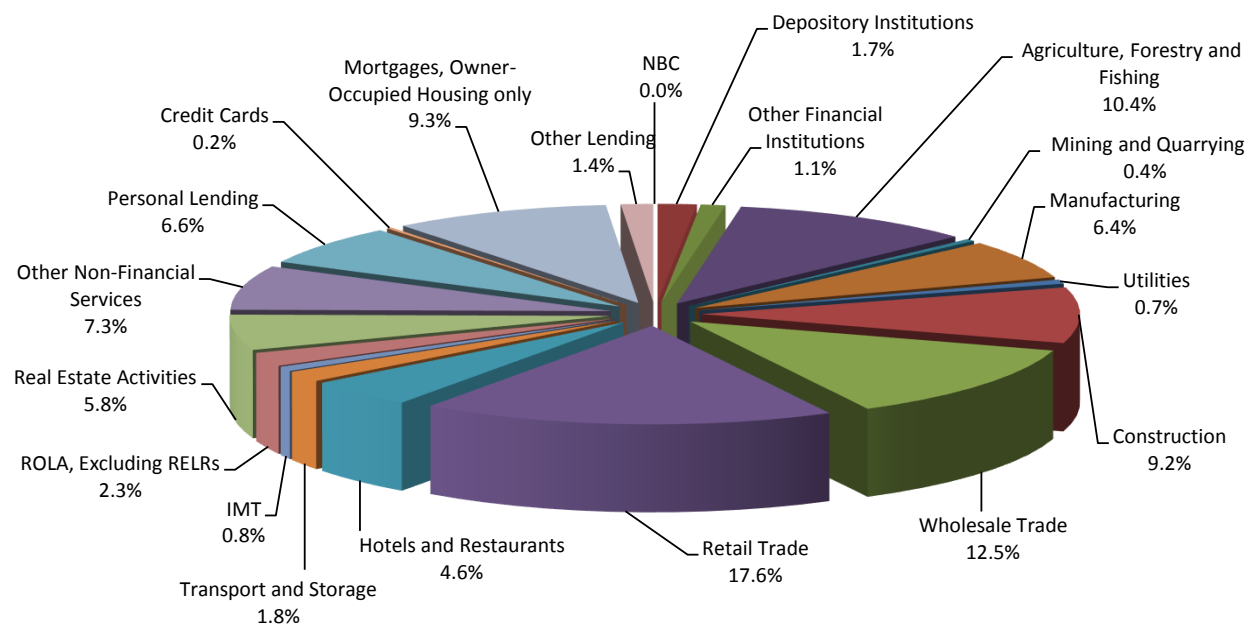

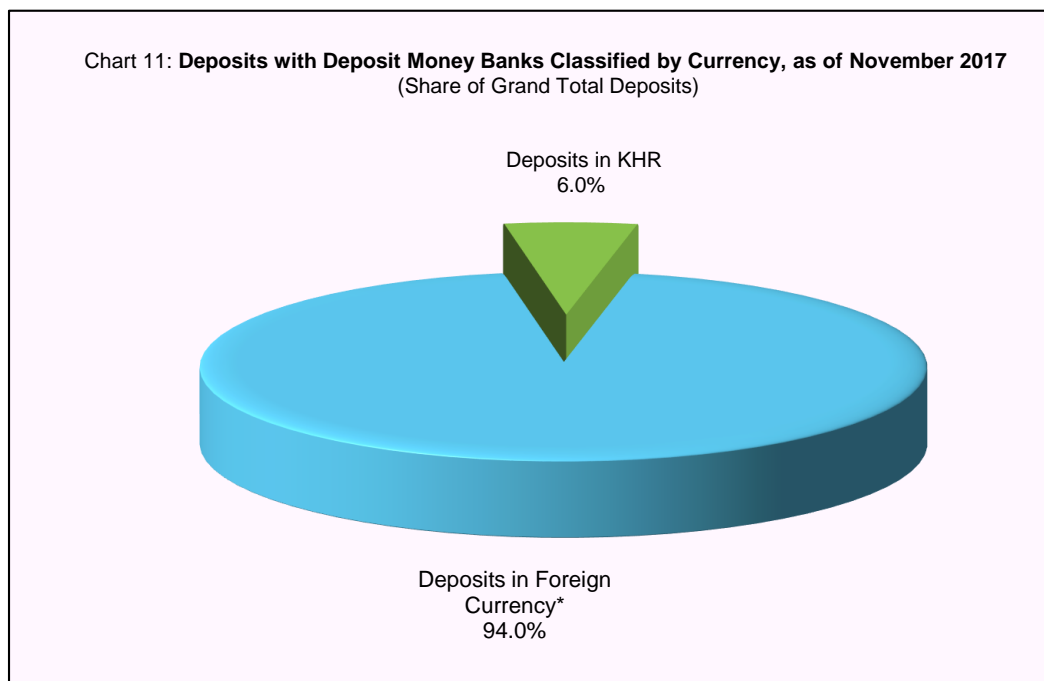

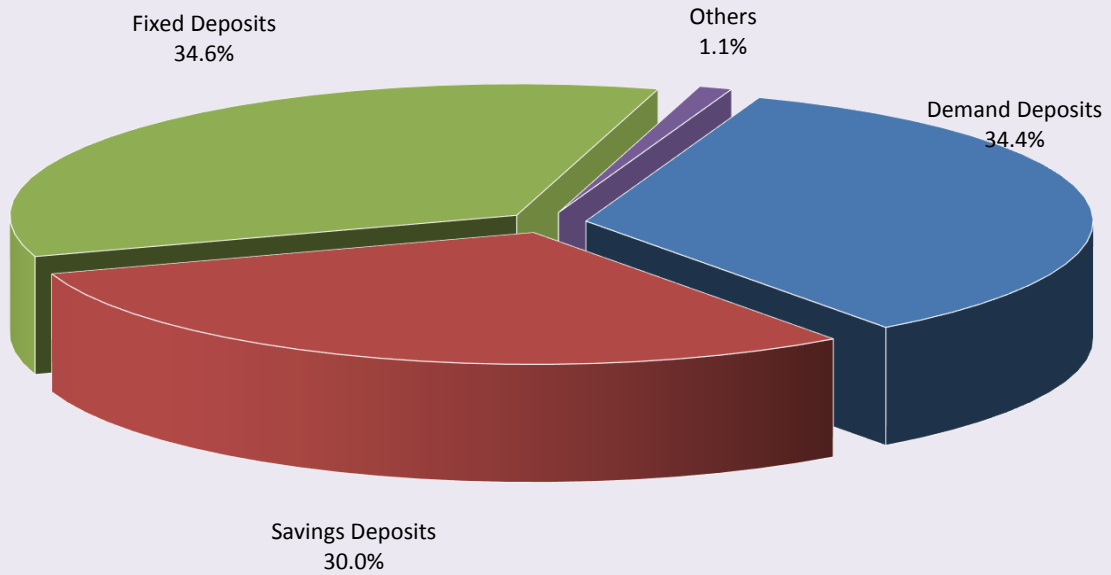

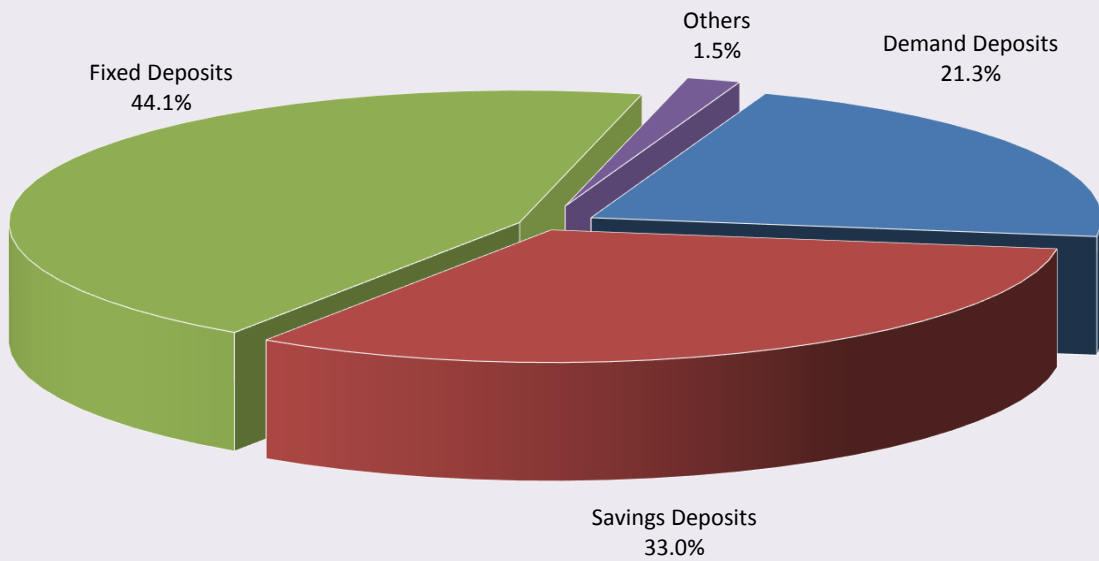
