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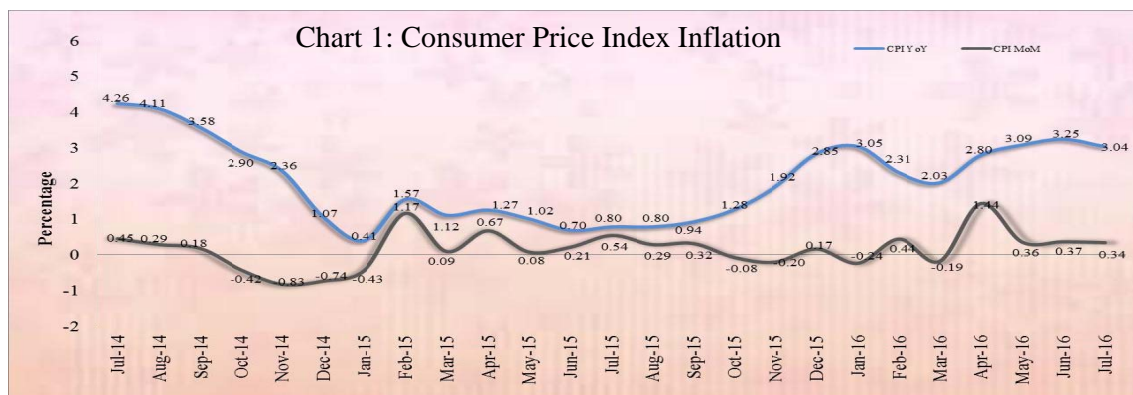
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Introduction

Overall consumer price inflation in July 2016 decelerated, compared to a month earlier. During this period, Cambodian Riel (KHR) depreciated against US dollar while total credit to private sector and resident deposits of the banking system continued to increase. At the same time, the international trade in goods showed a decrease in deficit.

Consumer Price Index

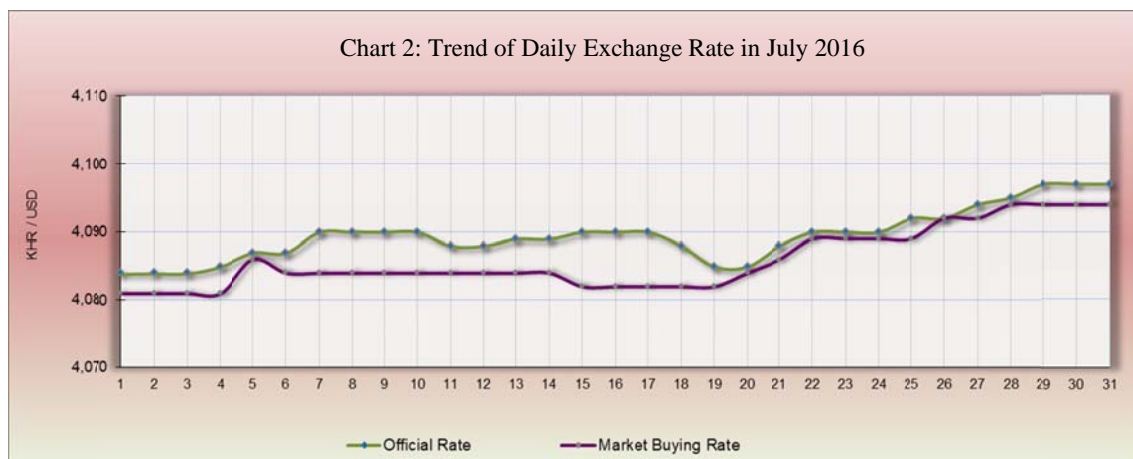
The consumer price inflation in Phnom Penh (month-on-month) decreased slightly to 0.34% in July from 0.37% in June 2016. In which, four out of twelve group indexes decreased while the other seven group indexes increased and one group index remained stable.



During the same period, the year-on-year percentage change of the CPI for all items decelerated to 3.04% in July 2016 from 3.25% in June, mainly reflected by a decrease in oil price contributed with a slower hike in food price.

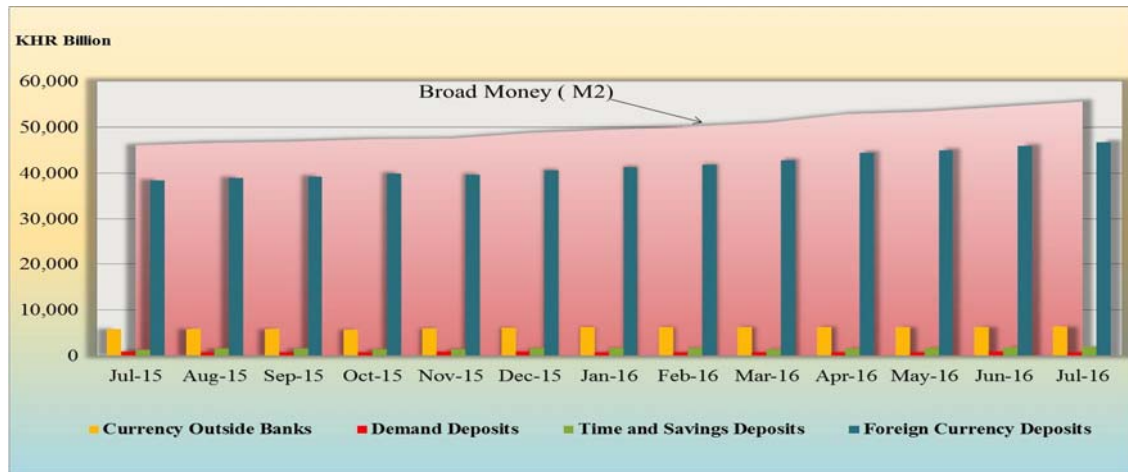
Exchange Rate

The exchange rate (market buying rate) was KHR 4,094 per US dollar in July 2016, depreciated by 0.32%, compared to the previous month. This was mainly due to the seasonal factor, especially rainy season.



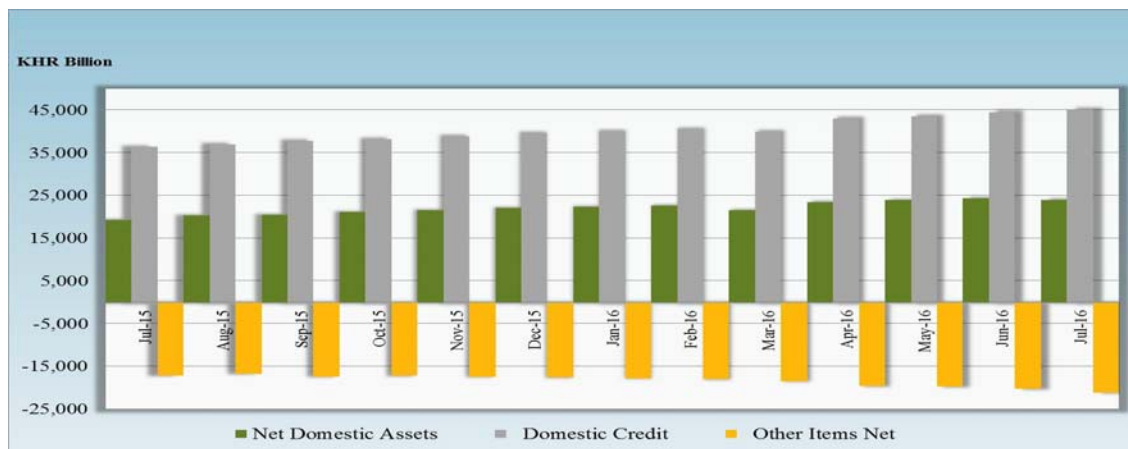
Money Supply

Broad money (M2) increased to KHR 55,608.7 billion in July 2016, up 2% compared to June. The components of M2 including time and saving deposits, resident's foreign currency deposits, and currency outside banks increased by 6.5%, 2%, and 1.4%, respectively, while demand deposits decreased by 4.1%.



Net Domestic Assets of the Banking Sector

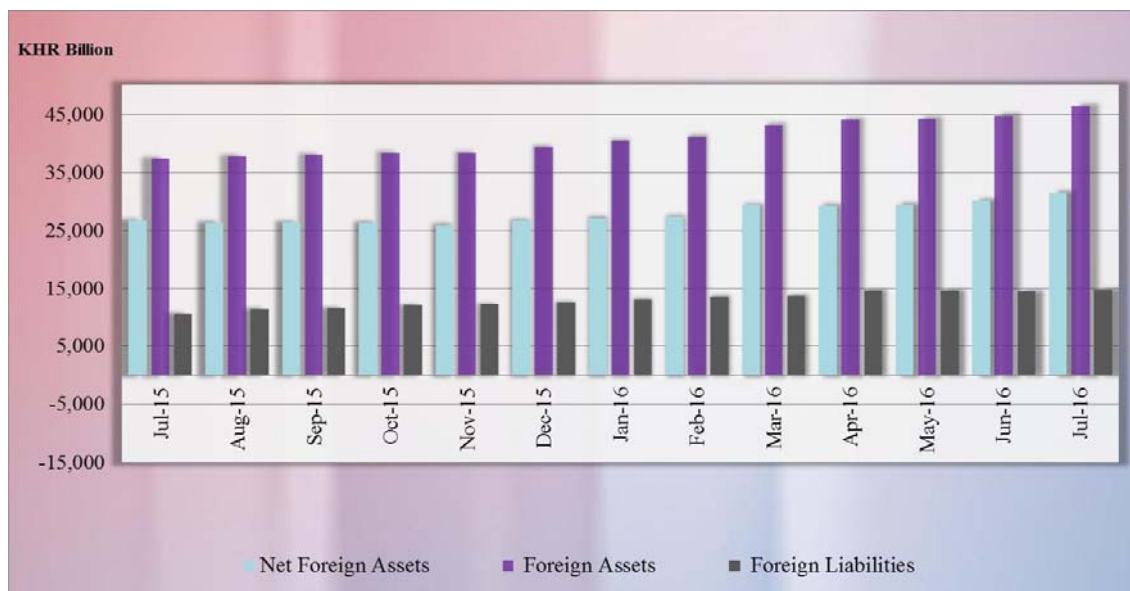
Net domestic assets of the banking sector in July 2016 decreased to KHR 24,105.1 billion, down 1.2% from the previous month, due to a decrease of 4.4% in other items net while domestic credit increased by 1.3%.



The decline in other items net was mainly due to the increases of 3% in capital and reserves and 2.6% in restricted deposits. The increase in domestic credit was reflected by an increase of 1.2% in credit to private sectors while net claims on government decreased by 0.3%.

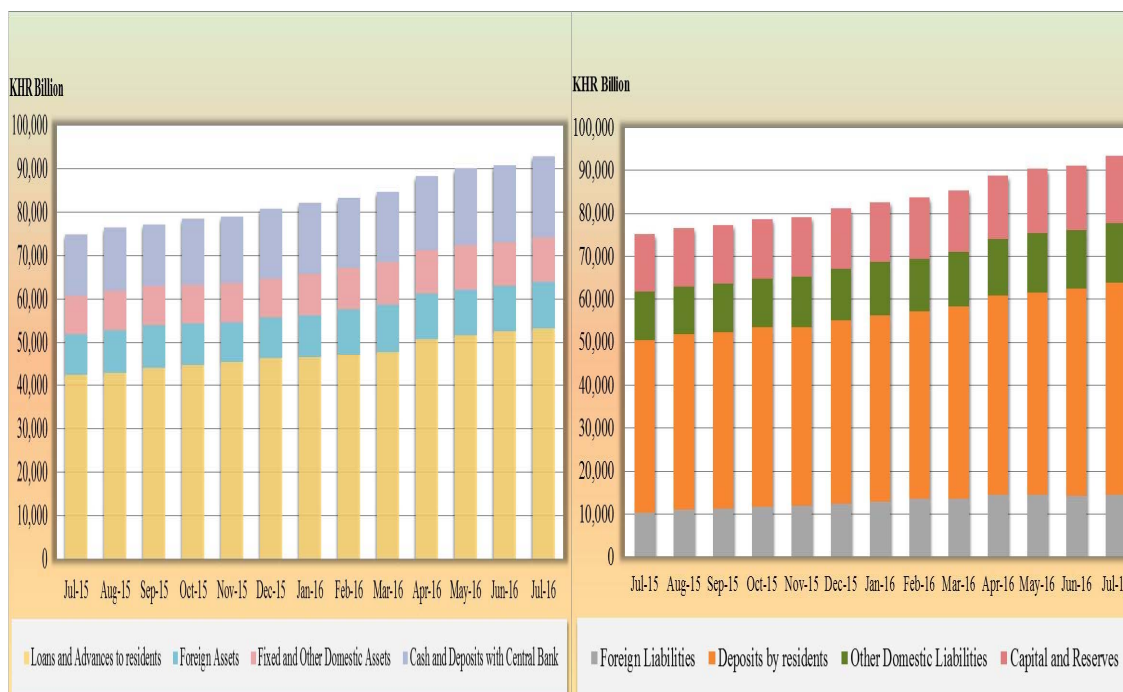
Net Foreign Assets of the Banking Sector

Net foreign assets of the banking sector increased markedly to KHR 31,503.6 billion in July 2016, up by 4.5% from June, mainly due to an increase of 3.7% in total foreign assets.



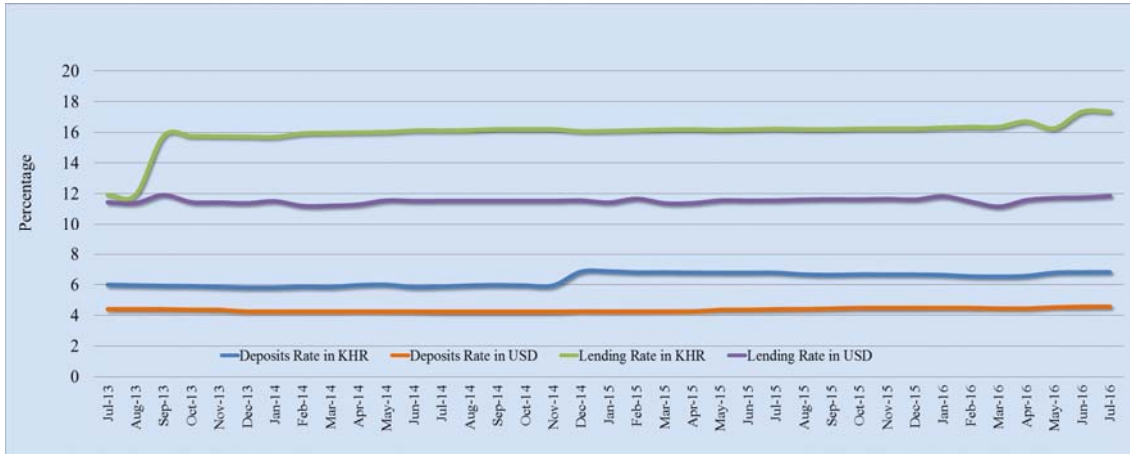
Deposit Money Banks' Operations

Total assets of commercial banks and specialized banks were KHR 93,202.7 billion, up by 2.3% in July 2016 compared to the previous month.



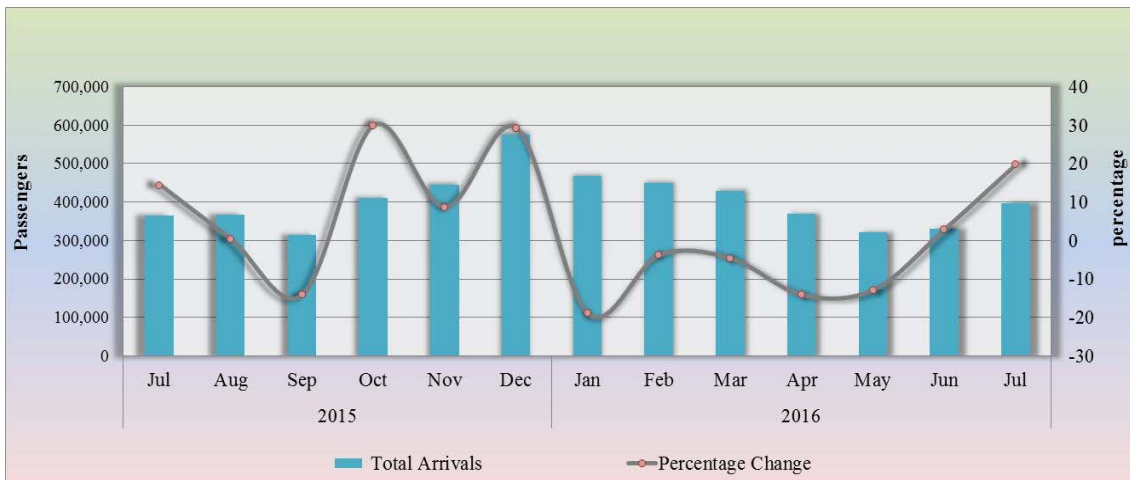
Interest Rates on Loans and Deposits

In July 2016, the interest rate movement with a 12-month maturity on deposits and loans showed that the weighted average deposit rate in KHR increased by 0.01% and deposit in US Dollar increased by 0.02%. At the same time, the weighted average lending rate in KHR increased by 0.01% and lending rate in US dollar increased by 0.1%.

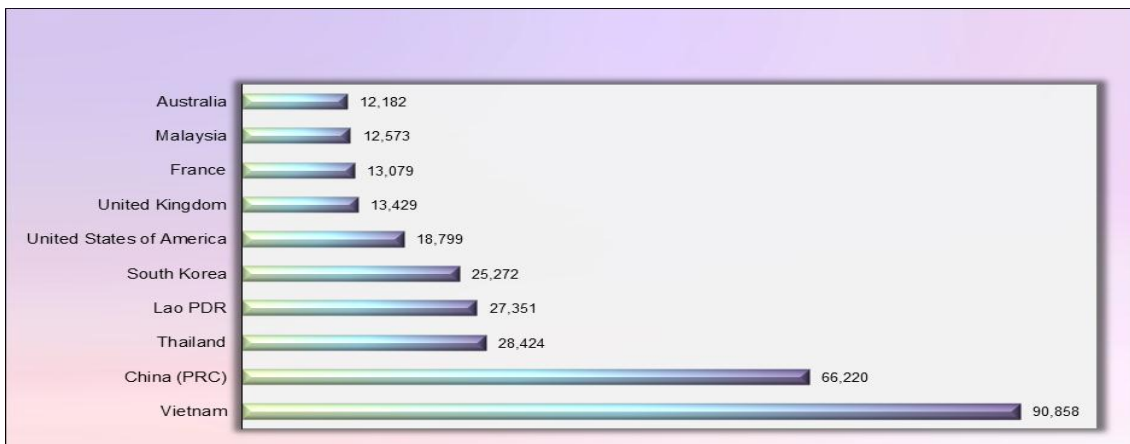


Foreign Tourist Arrivals

In July 2016, the total number of passenger arrivals was 395,761 passengers; increased by 19.9% following the increase of 3% in the preceding month. The main purpose of the passenger arrivals in Cambodia was for vacation, accounting for more than 87% of the total.

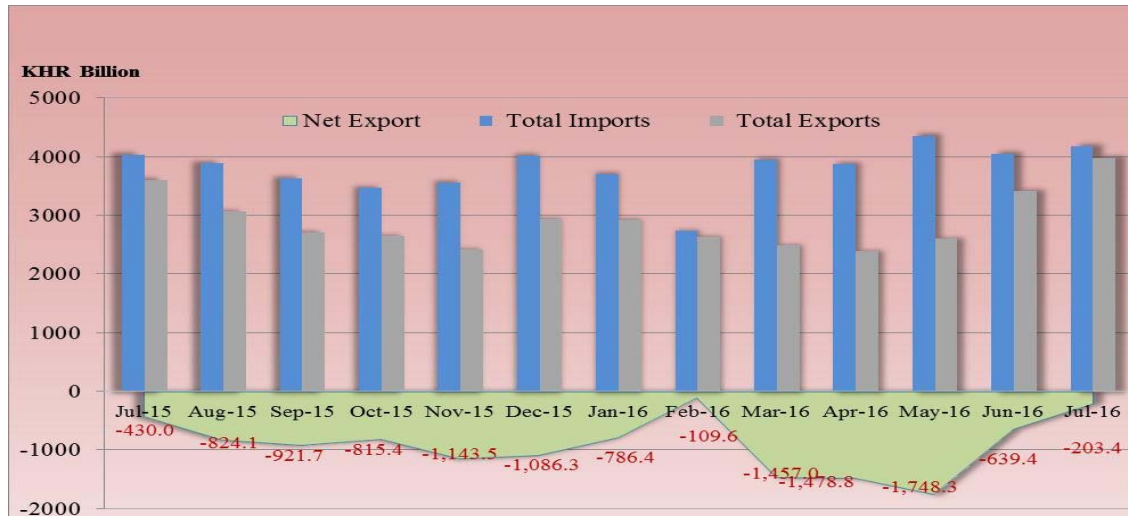


Most of the foreign passengers were from Vietnam, China P.R.C., Thailand, Lao PDR, South Korea, United States of America, United Kingdom, France, Malaysia, and Australia.



International Trade in Goods

International trade in goods showed a deficit of KHR 203.4 billion (4.9%) in July 2016, from the deficit of KHR 639.4 billion (15.8%) in June 2016.



The major components of total exports were Garment, Footwear, Rubber, and Textile. And the major components of total imports were Petroleum, Vehicles, Cigarettes, Construction Materials, Motor Bikes, Steel, Clothing, Cement, Cloths, Gold, and Sugar.

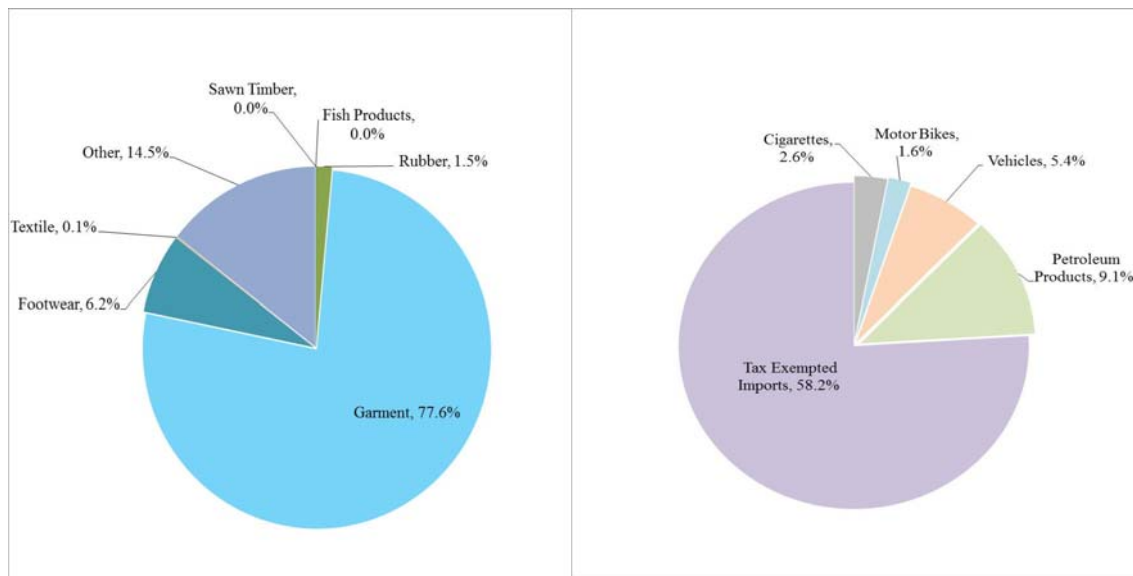

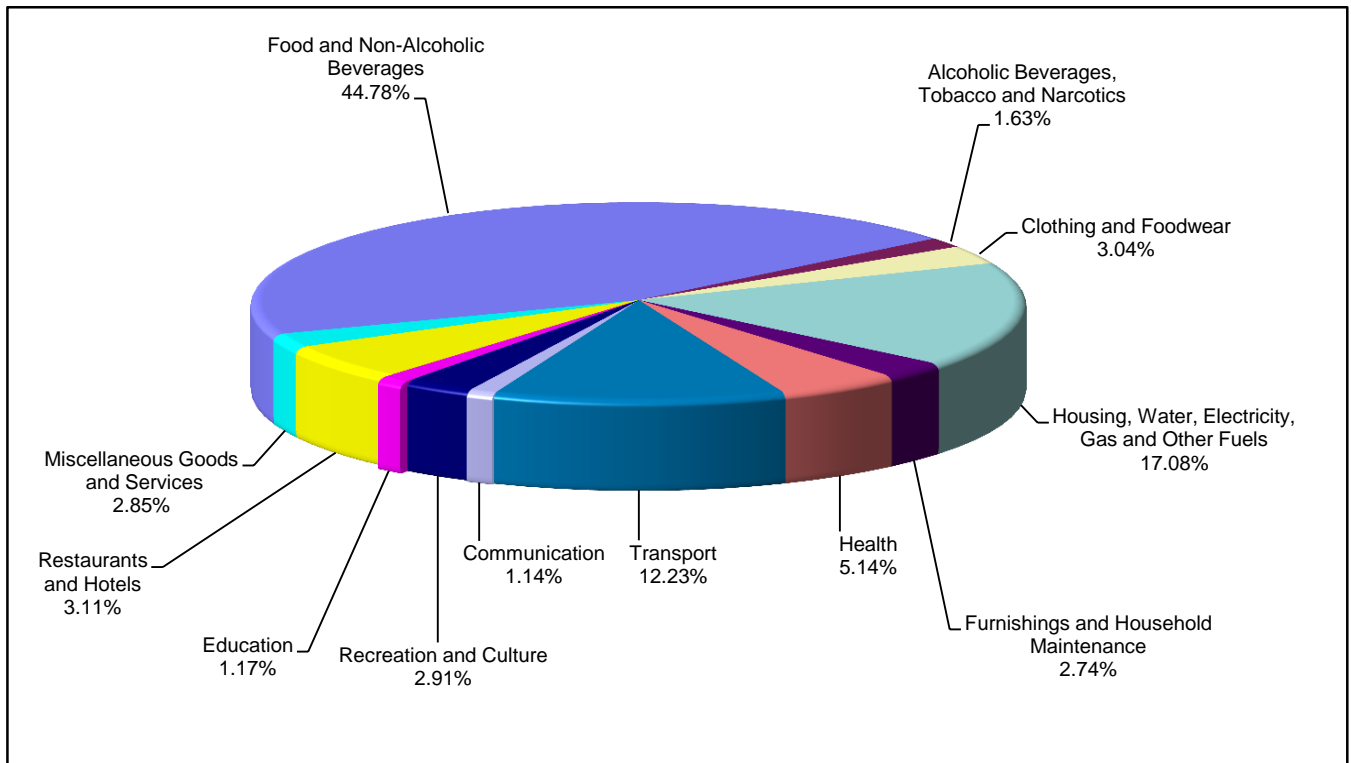

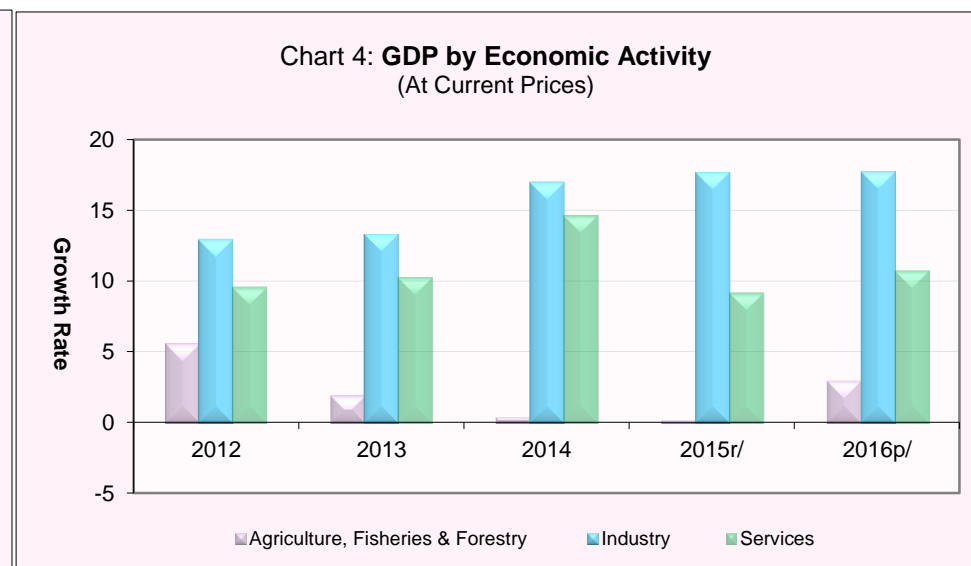
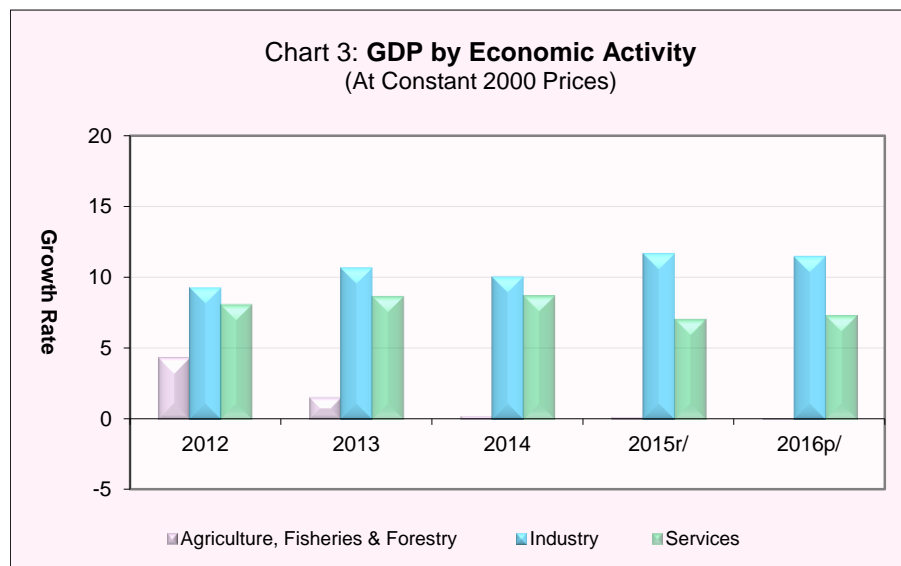
Chart 2: Weight of All Group Indices in Consumer Basket

Chart 5: Investment Fixed Assets by Sectors

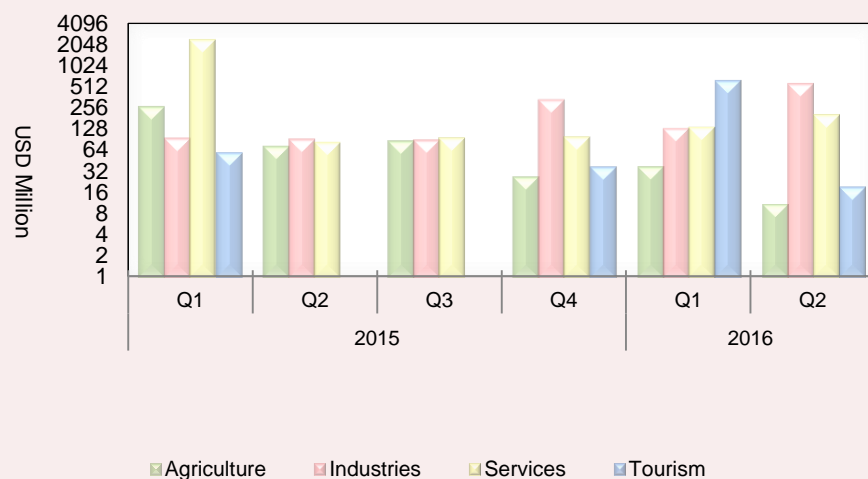
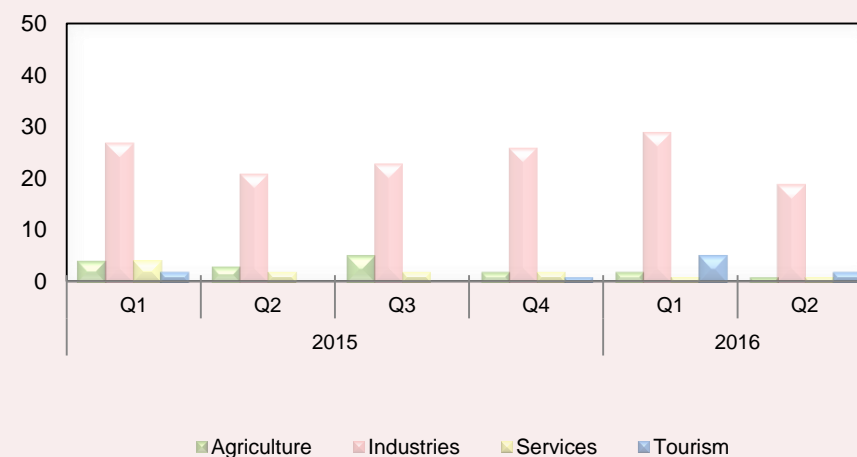


Chart 6: Number of Investment Projects by Sectors

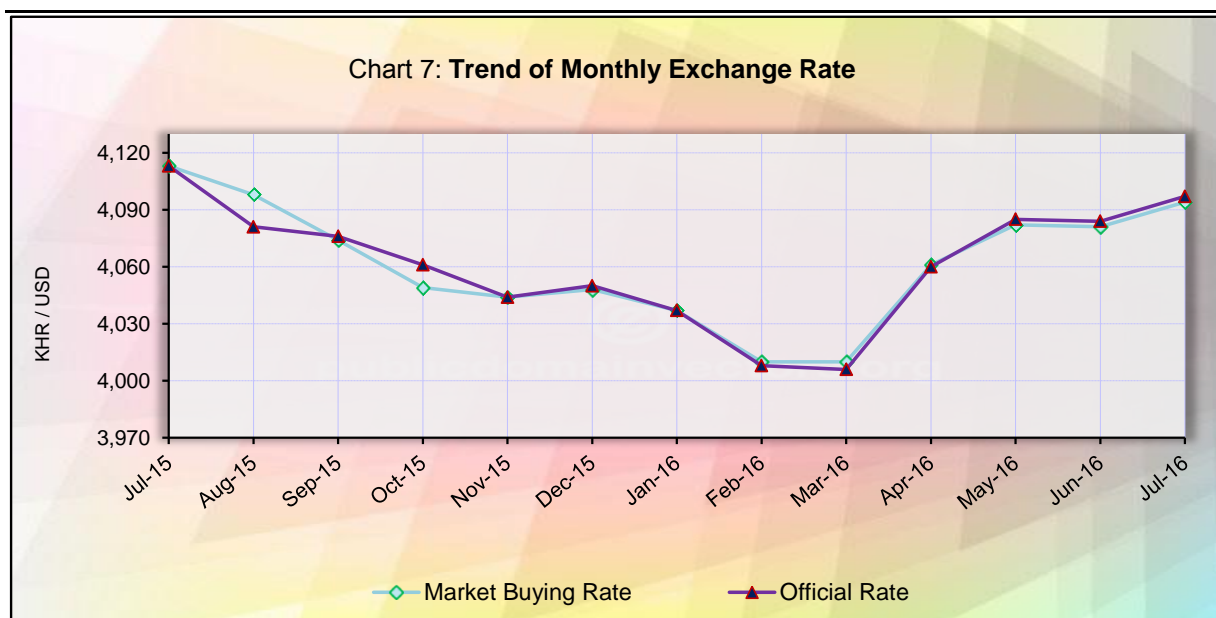

Chart 8: Monetary Survey

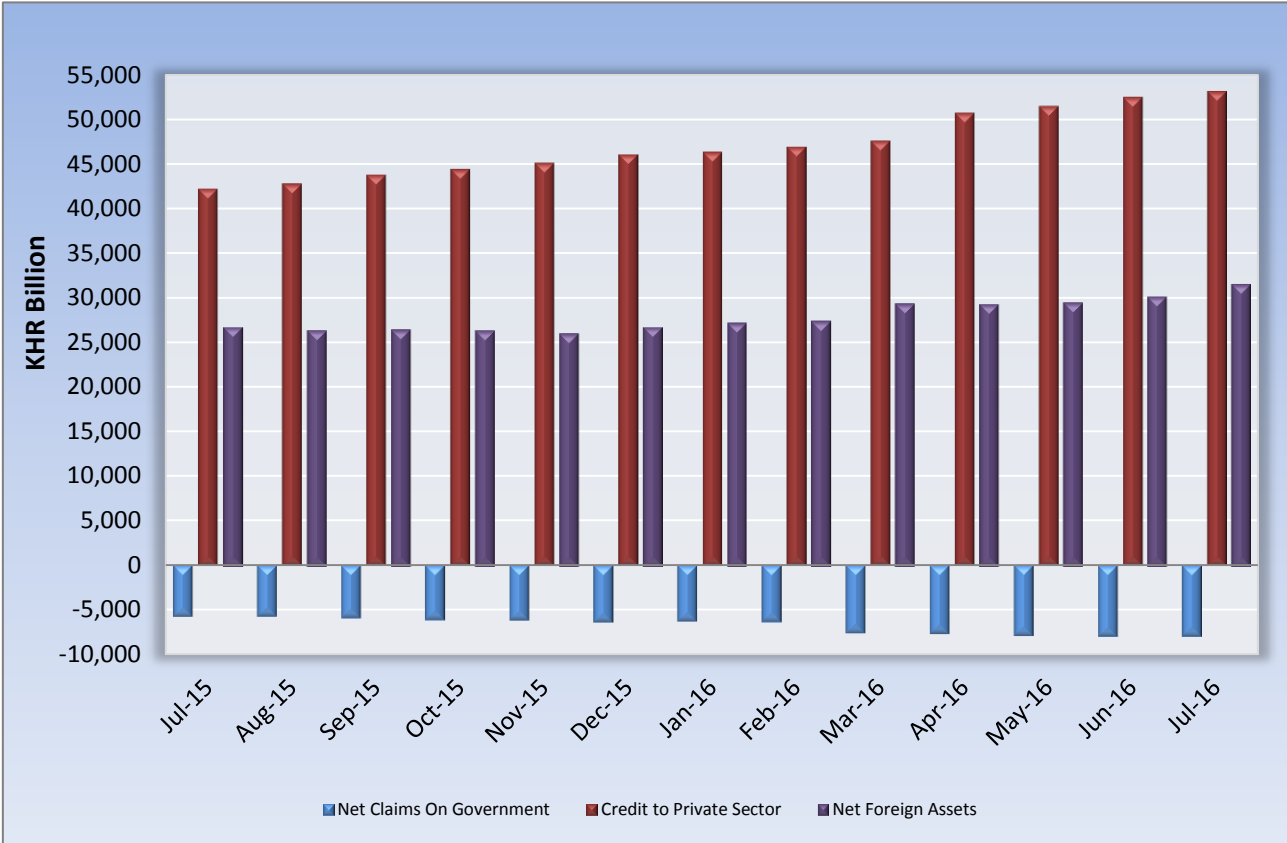


Chart 9: Components of Money Supply

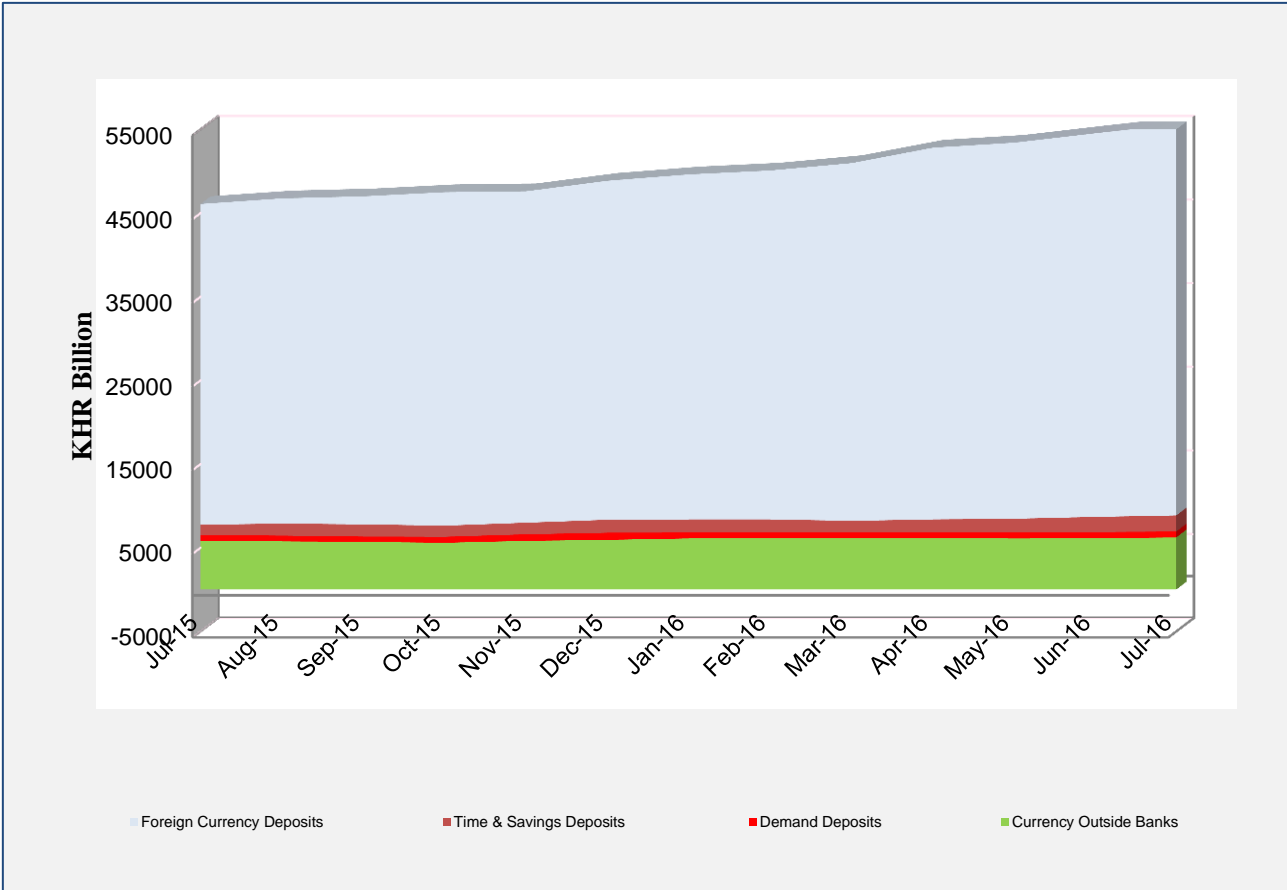

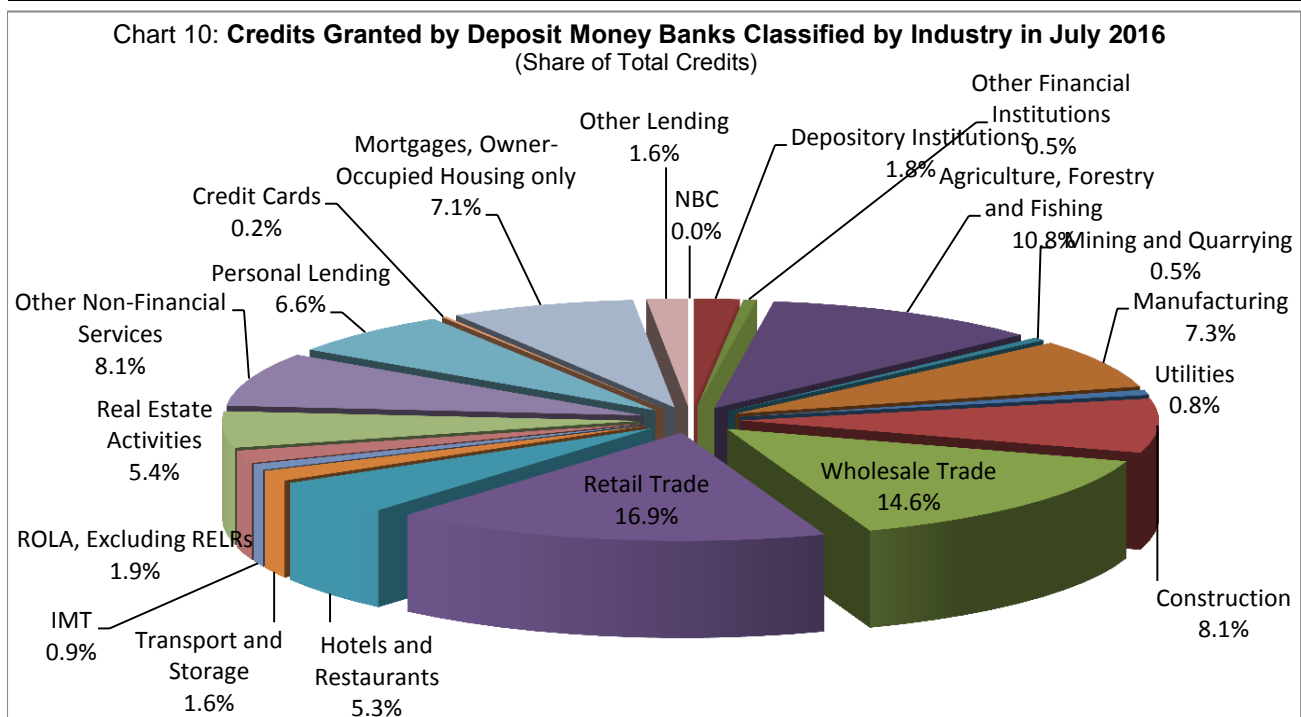

(Share of Grand Total Deposits)

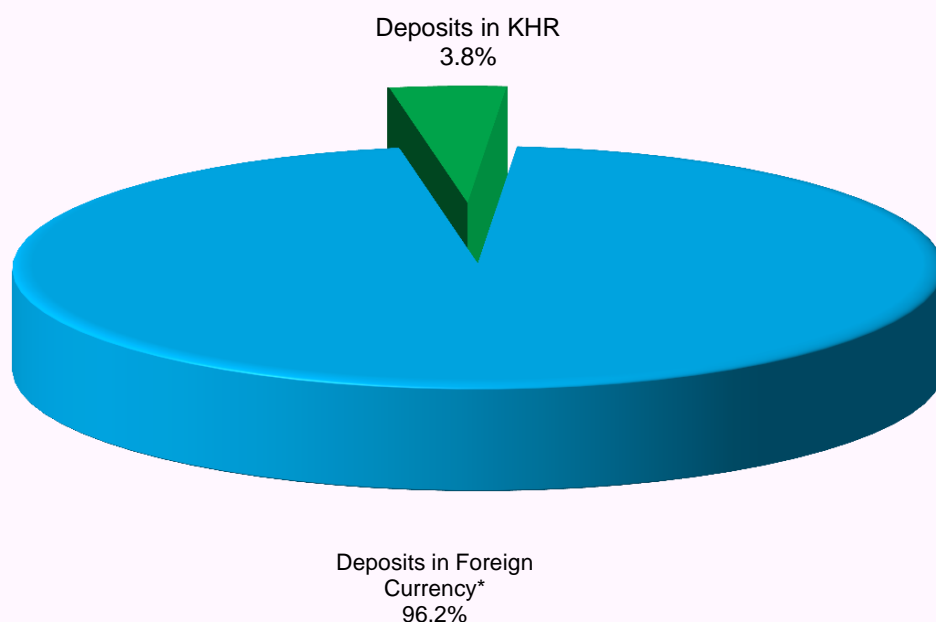

(Share of Total KHR Deposits)

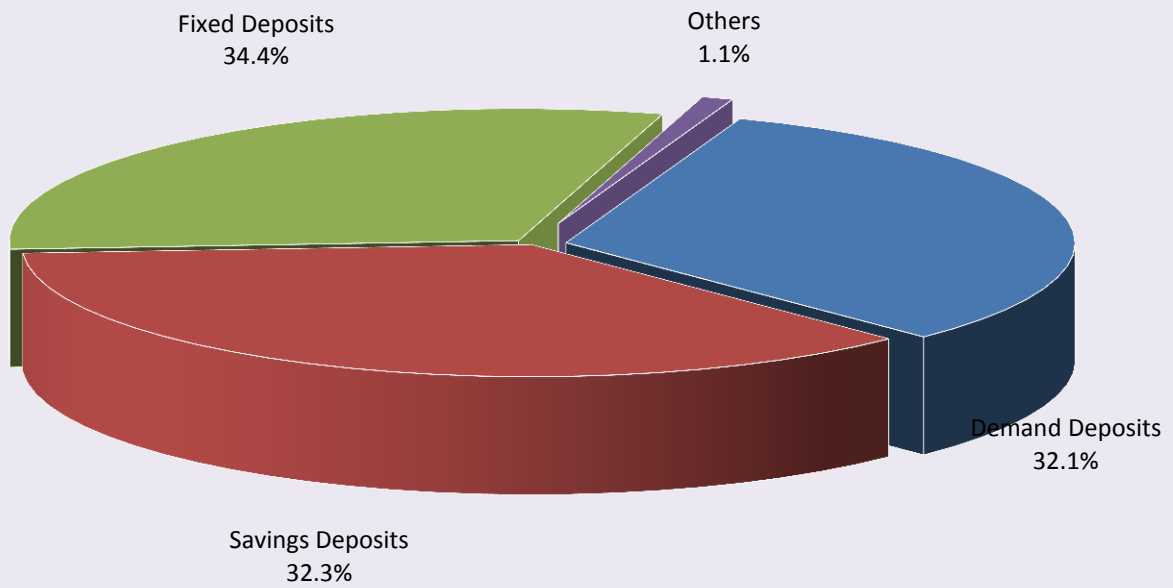
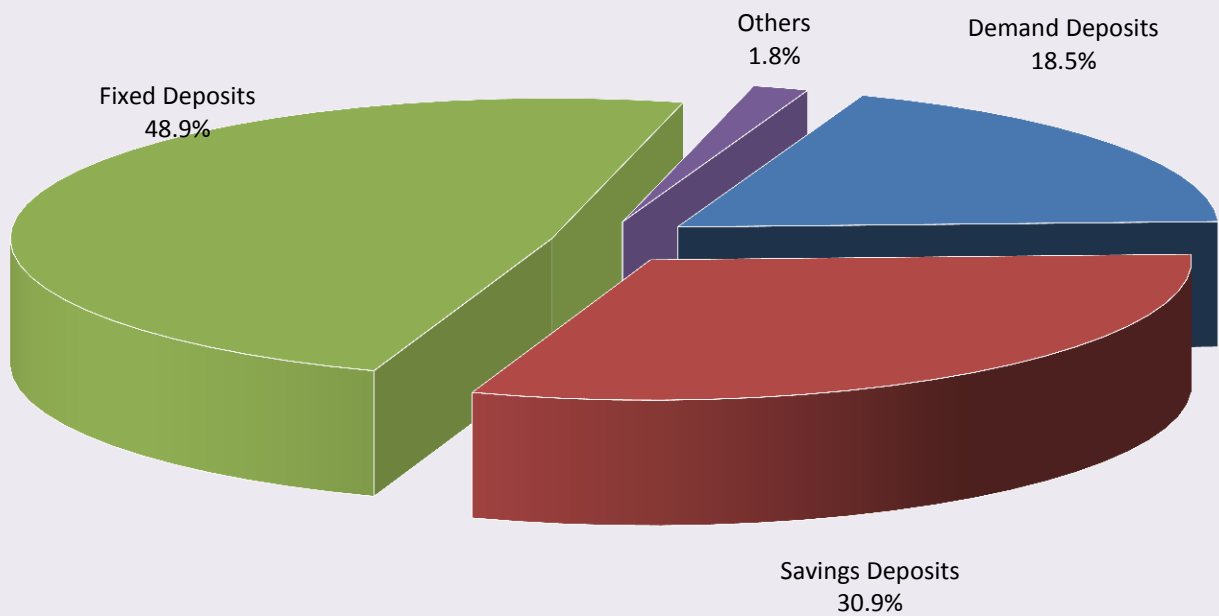


Chart 13: Deposits in Foreign Currency Classified by Type, as of July 2016
