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## Introduction

Overall consumer price inflation in October 2016 accelerated, compared to a month earlier. During this period, Cambodian Riel (KHR) appreciated against US dollar while financial intermediation through banking system which reflected by total credit to private sector and resident deposits continued to increase. At the same time, the international trade in goods showed an increase in deficit.

## Consumer Price Index

The consumer price inflation in Phnom Penh (month-on-month) continued to increase to 0.37% in October from 0.28% in September 2016. In which, seven out of twelve group indexes increased while the other four group indexes decreased and one group index remained stable.



During the same period, the year-on-year percentage change of the CPI for all items accelerated to 3.35% in October 2016 from 2.89% in September, reflected mainly by an increase in food price.


## Exchange Rate

The exchange rate (market buying rate) was KHR 4,053 per US dollar in October 2016, appreciated by 0.8%, compared to the previous month. This was due to the increase in demand for KHR for tax payment purpose and for spending during national festival days.




## Money Supply

Broad money (M2) increased to KHR 57,595.4 billion in October 2016, up 0.8% compared to September. The components of M2 including time and saving deposits and resident's foreign currency deposits increased by 7.7% and 1.2%, respectively while demand deposits and currency outside banks declined by 4.3% and 3.8%, respectively.



## Net Domestic Assets of the Banking Sector


Net domestic assets of the banking sector in October 2016 continued to increase to KHR 24,989.2 billion, up 0.2% from the previous month, this was due to an increase of 0.1% in domestic credit and 0.1% in other items net.



The increase in domestic credit was reflected by an increase of 0.1% in credit to private sectors while net claims on government declined by 0.5%. The increase in other items net was mainly due to a decrease of 1.9% in capital and reserves.


## Net Foreign Assets of the Banking Sector

Net foreign assets of the banking sector continued to increase to KHR 32,606.2 billion in October 2016, up by 1.3% from September, mainly due to an increase of 0.5% in total foreign assets contributed with a decrease of 1.3% in foreign liabilities.




## Deposit Money Banks' Operations

Total assets of commercial banks and specialized banks were KHR 95,596 billion, up by 1% in October 2016 compared to the previous month.




## Interest Rates on Loans and Deposits

In October 2016, the interest rate movement with a maturity of 12-month on deposits and loans showed that the weighted average deposit rate in KHR increased by 0.06% and deposit in US Dollar increased by 0.01%. At the same time, the weighted average lending rate in KHR increased by 0.01% while lending rate in US dollar decreased by 0.02%.




## Foreign Tourist Arrivals

In October 2016, the total number of passenger arrivals was 414,077 passengers; increased by 19.8% after decreasing 14.9% in the preceding month. The main purpose of the passenger arrivals in Cambodia was for vacation, accounting for more than 87% of the total.




Most of the foreign passengers were from China P.R.C., Vietnam, Lao PDR, Thailand, South Korea, United States of America, Malaysia, Japan, United Kingdom, and France.




## International Trade in Goods

International trade in goods showed a deficit of KHR 1,430.9 billion (37.8%) in October 2016, from the deficit of KHR 554.5 billion (15.2%) in September 2016.



The major components of total exports were Garment, Footwear, Rubber, and Textile. And the major components of total imports were Petroleum, Gold, Vehicles, Motor Bikes, Cigarettes, Construction Materials, Steel, Clothing, Cement, Sugar, and Cloths.





### Chart 2: Weight of All Group Indices in Consumer Basket


















**Chart 11: Deposits with Deposit Money Banks Classified by Currency, as of October 2016**  
(Share of Grand Total Deposits)




