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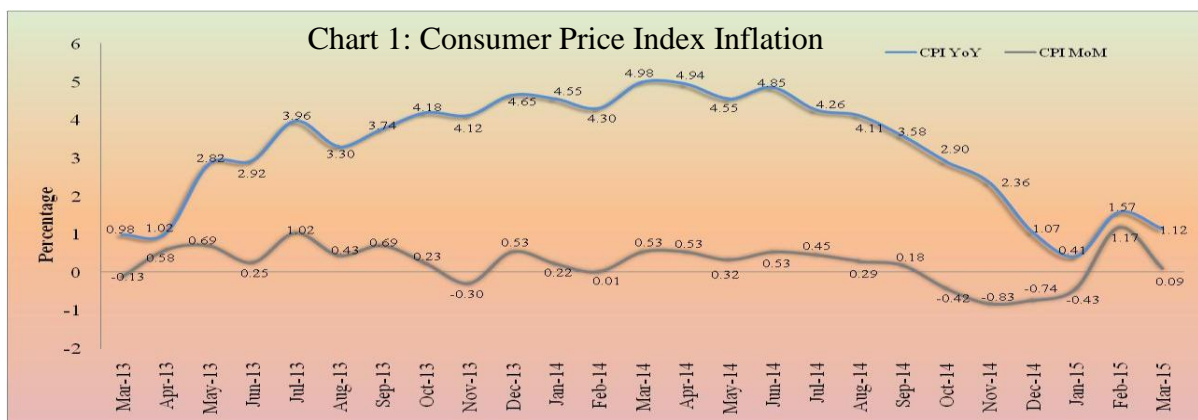
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Introduction

Headline consumer price inflation in March 2015 decelerated slightly after surging notably in the preceding month. During this period, Cambodian Riel (KHR) continued to appreciate against US dollar whereas banking financial intermediary continued to improve. At the same time, the international trade in goods showed a decrease in deficit.

Consumer Price Index

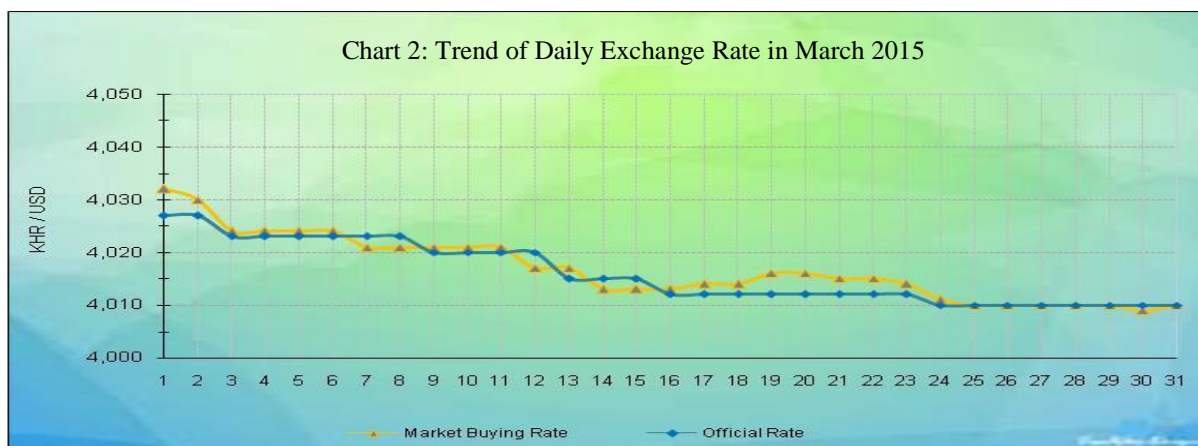
The consumer price inflation in Phnom Penh (month-on-month) eased to 0.09% in March from 1.17% in February 2015. In which, eight out of twelve group indexes increased while three group indexes decreased and the other group index remained stable.



During the same period, the year-on-year percentage change of the CPI for all items eased to 1.12% in March from 1.57% in February 2015, mainly due to a decrease in oil price and lower hike in food price.

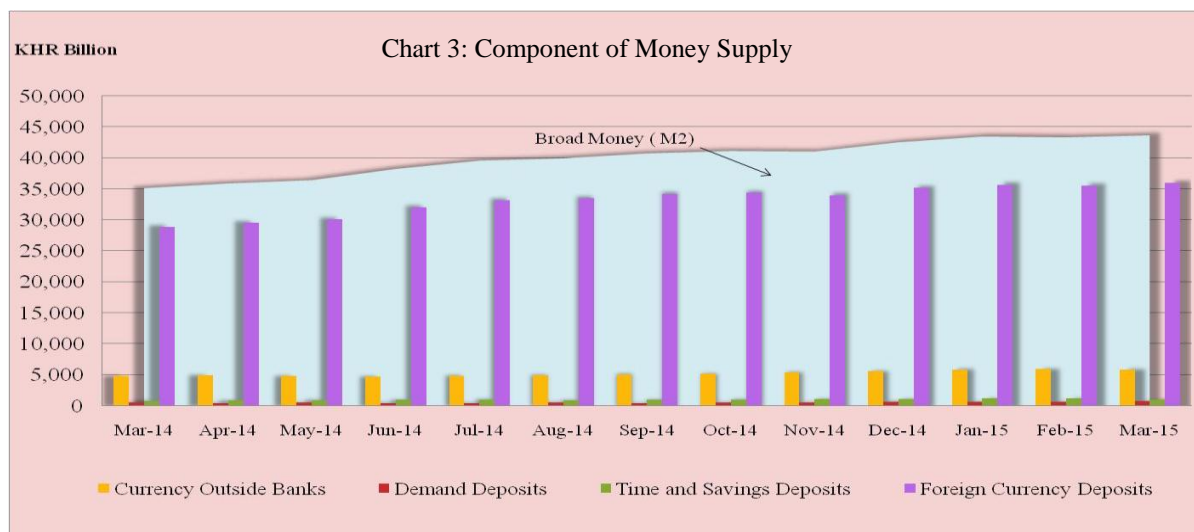
Exchange Rate

The exchange rate (market buying rate) was KHR 4,010 per US dollar in March 2015, appreciated by 0.55%, compared to the previous month. This was due to the increase in demand for KHR for tax payment purpose and settlements of agricultural products such as cassavas, cashew nuts and workers' wage payments during harvest season.



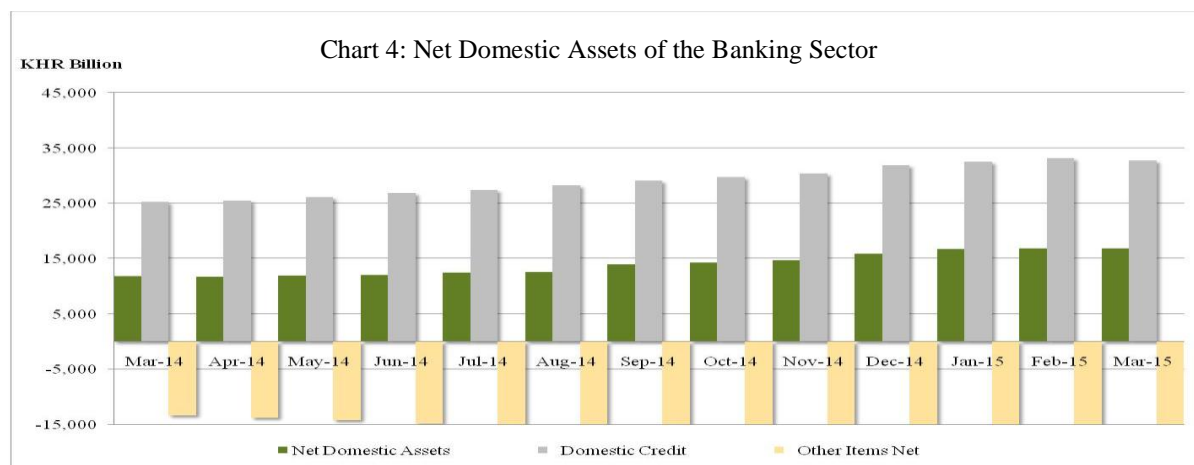
Money Supply

Broad money (M2) surged to KHR 43,686.2 billion in March 2015, up 0.8% compared to February 2015. The components of M2 including demand deposits increased by 13.8% and resident's foreign currency deposits increased by 1.2%, while time and saving deposits and currency outside banks decreased by 10.9% and 1.1%, respectively.



Net Domestic Assets of the Banking Sector

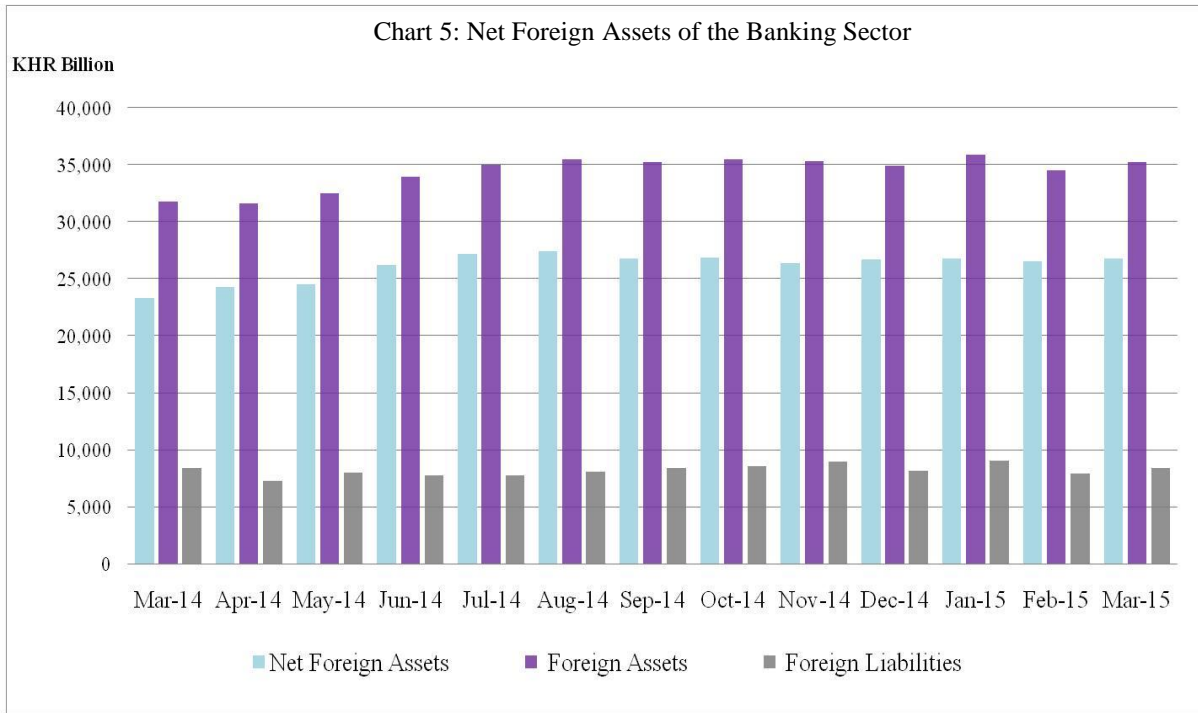
Net domestic assets of the banking sector in March 2015 continued to increase to KHR 16,863.2 billion, up 0.5% from the previous month, this was due to the increase of 3.1% in other items net while domestic credit decreased by 1.3%.



The decrease in domestic credit was reflected by a decrease of 23.6% in net claims on government while credit to private sectors increased by 1.5%.

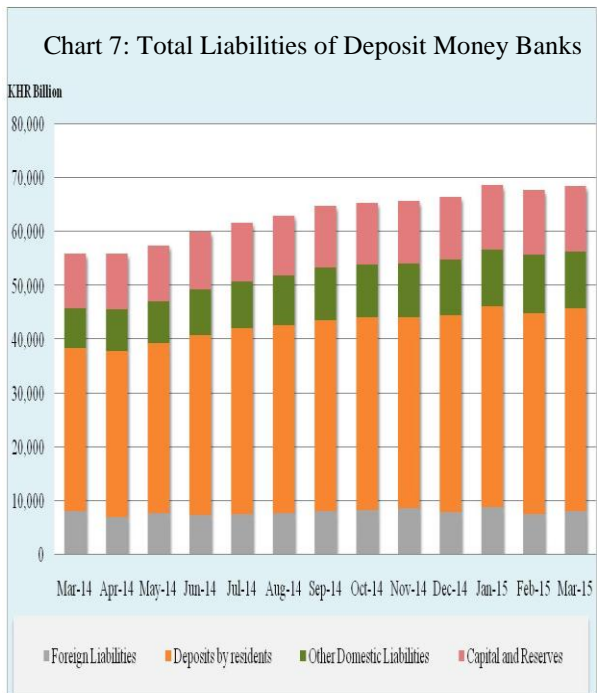
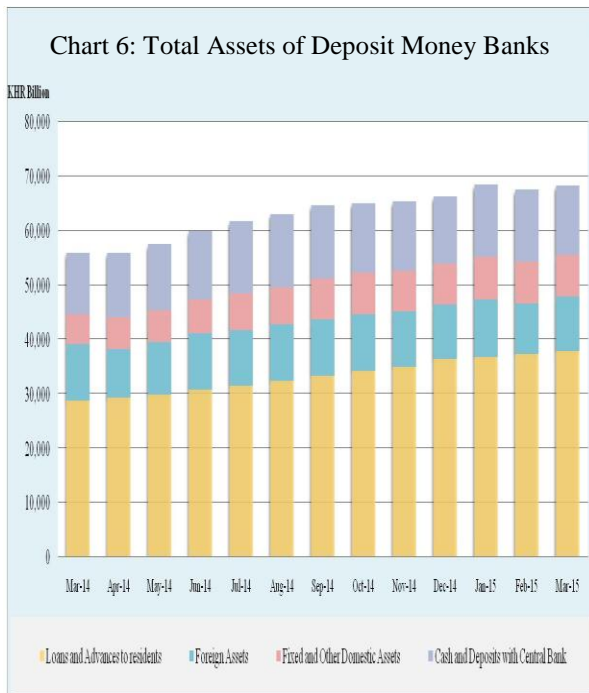
Net Foreign Assets of the Banking Sector

Net foreign assets of the banking sector increased to KHR 26,823 billion in March 2015, up by 0.9% from February 2015, mainly due to an increase of 2.2% in total foreign assets.



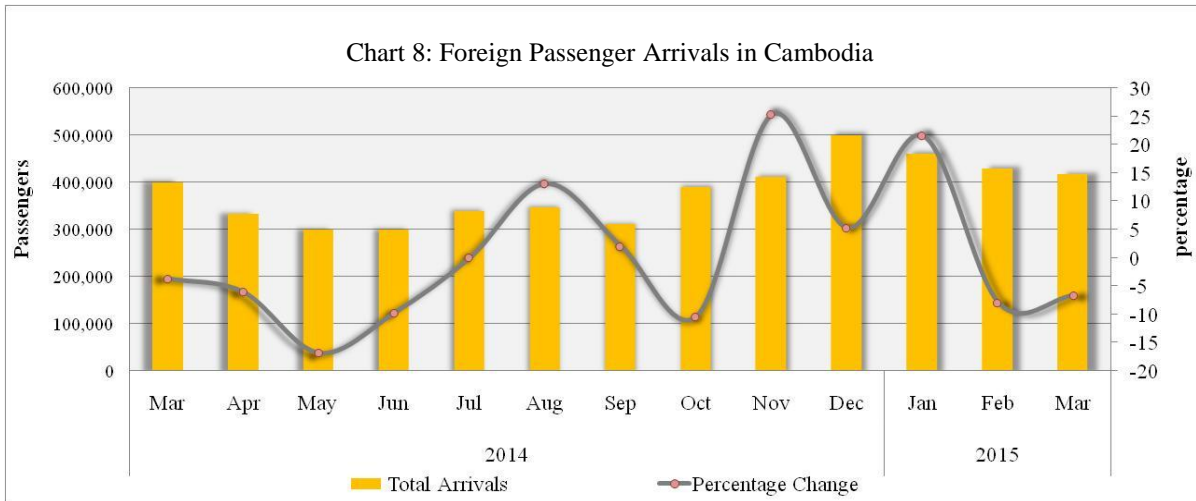
Deposit Money Banks' Operations

Total assets of commercial banks and specialized banks were KHR 68,342.1 billion, up by 1.2% in March 2015 from the previous month.

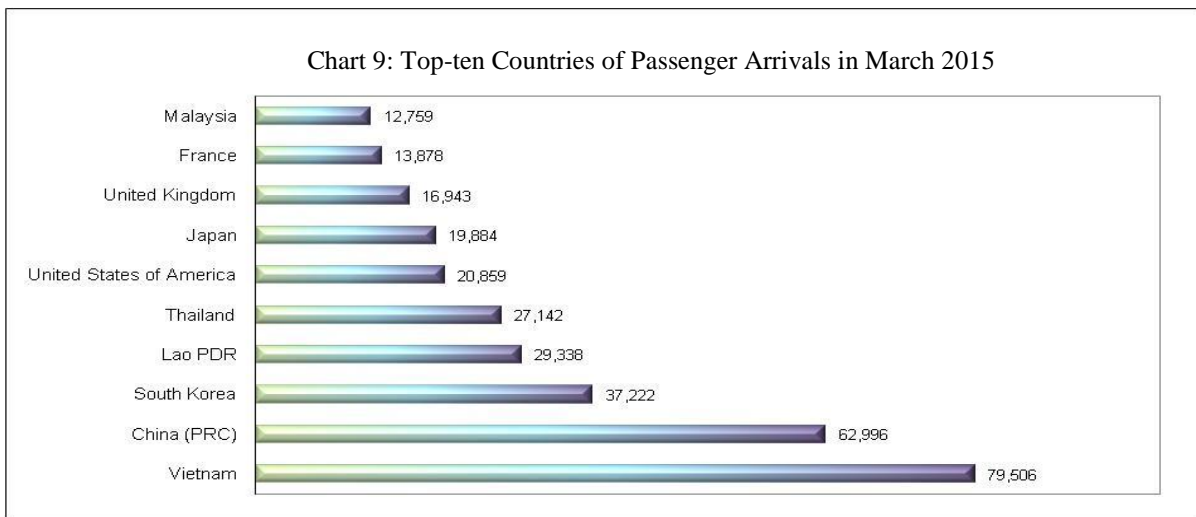


Foreign Tourist Arrivals

In March 2015, the total number of passenger arrivals was 417,052 passengers; down by 3.1% following the decrease of 6.6% last month. The main purpose of the passenger arrivals in Cambodia was for vacation, accounting for more than 89% of the total.

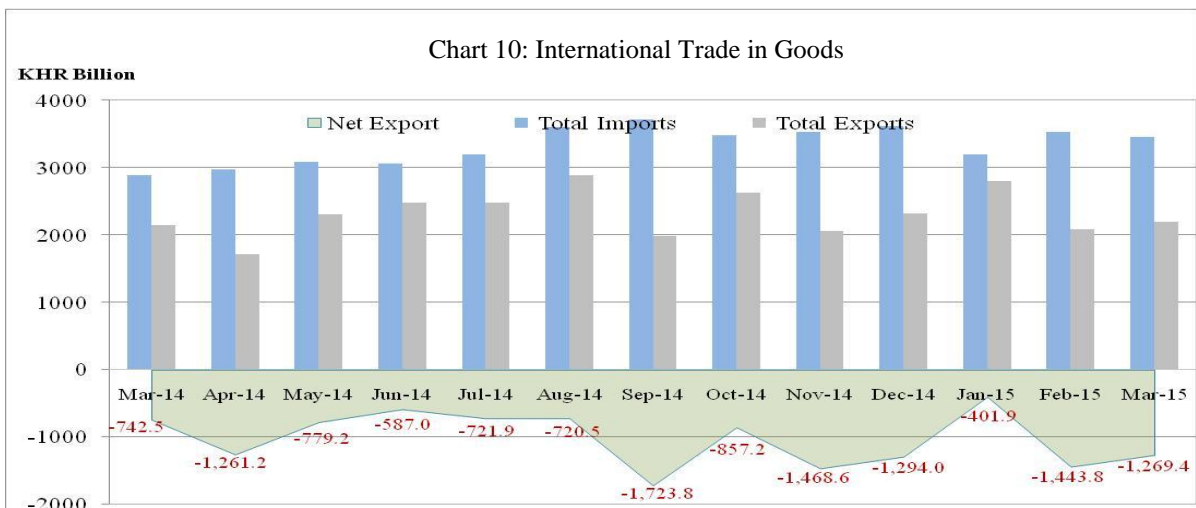


Most of the foreign passengers were from Vietnam, China P.R.C., South Korea, Lao PDR, Thailand, United States of America, Japan, United Kingdom, France, and Malaysia.



International Trade in Goods

International trade in goods showed a deficit of KHR 1,269.5 billion (36.7%) in March, from the deficit of KHR 1,443.8 billion (40.9%) in February 2015.



The major components of total exports were Garment, Footwear, Rubber, Sawn Timber, and Textile. And the major components of total imports were Gold, Petroleum, Vehicles, Motor Bikes, Steel, Cement, Construction Materials, Clothing, Cigarettes, Beer, and Cloths.

Chart 11: Components of Total Exports

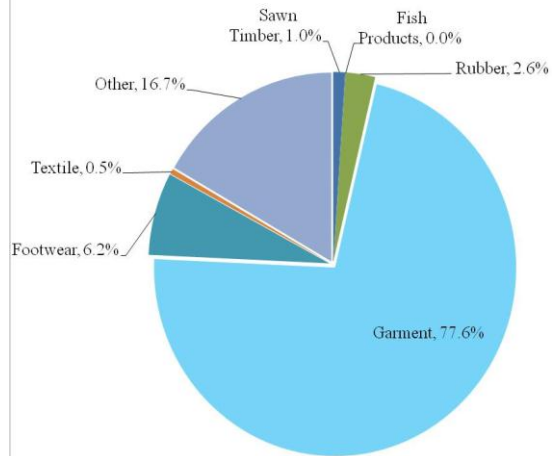


Chart 12: Components of Total Imports

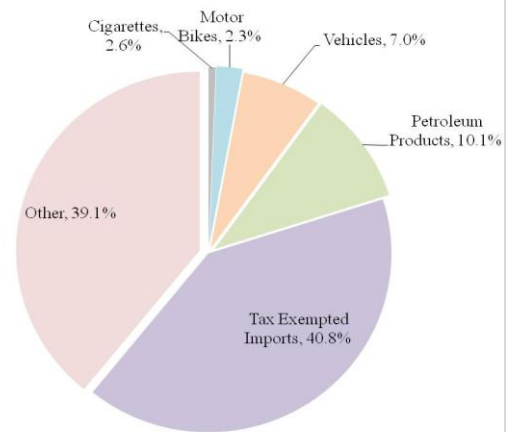

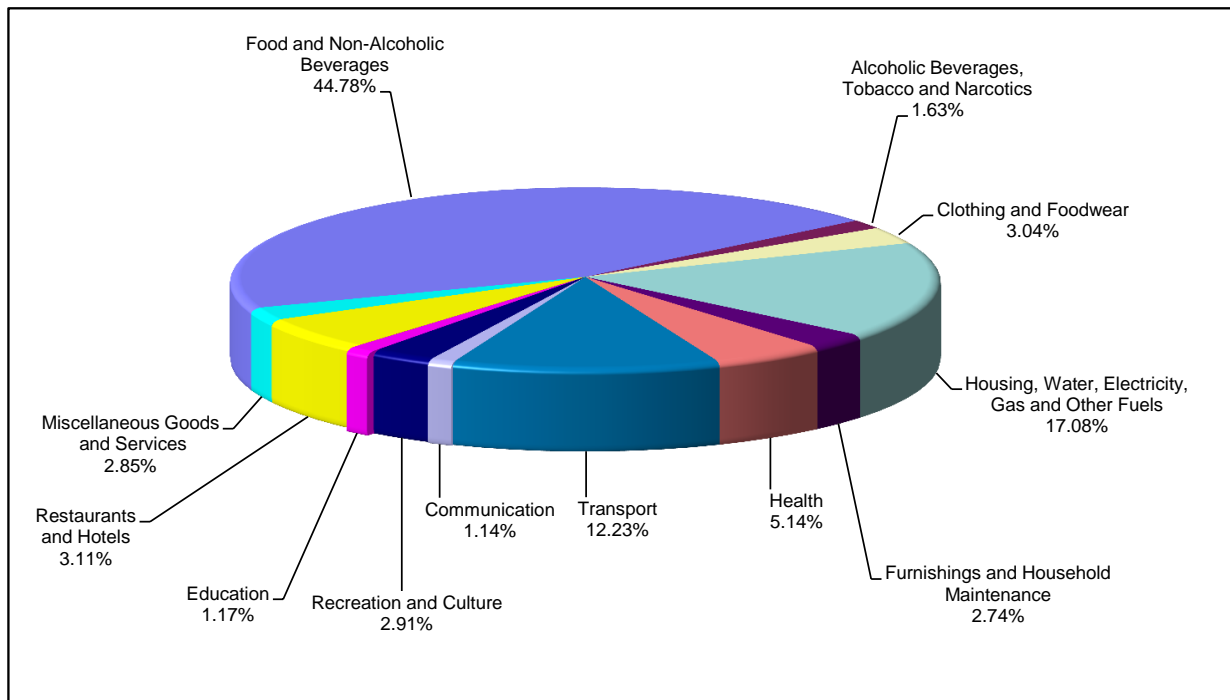

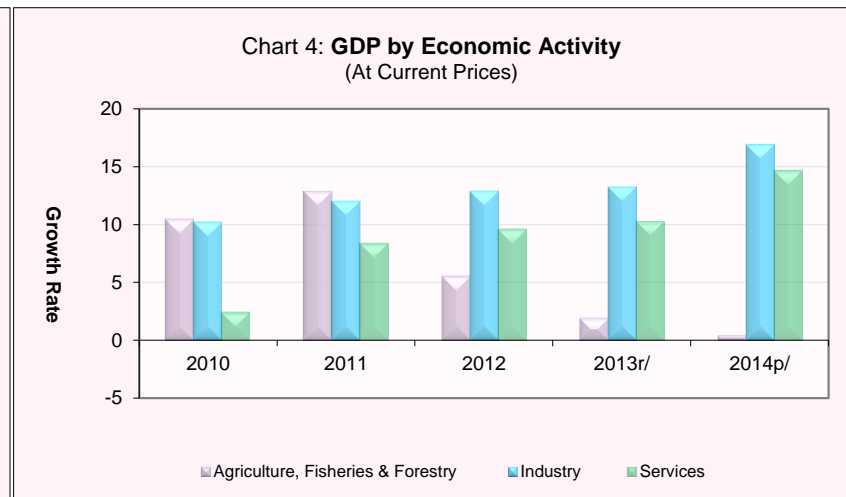
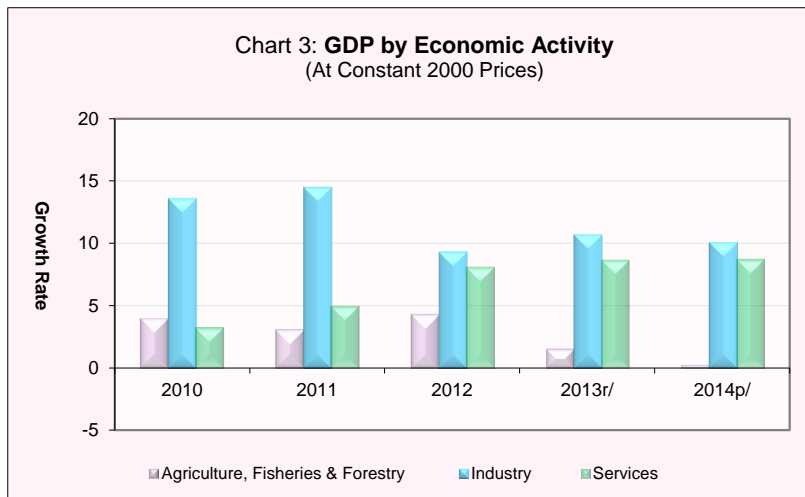
Chart 2: Weight of All Group Indices in Consumer Basket

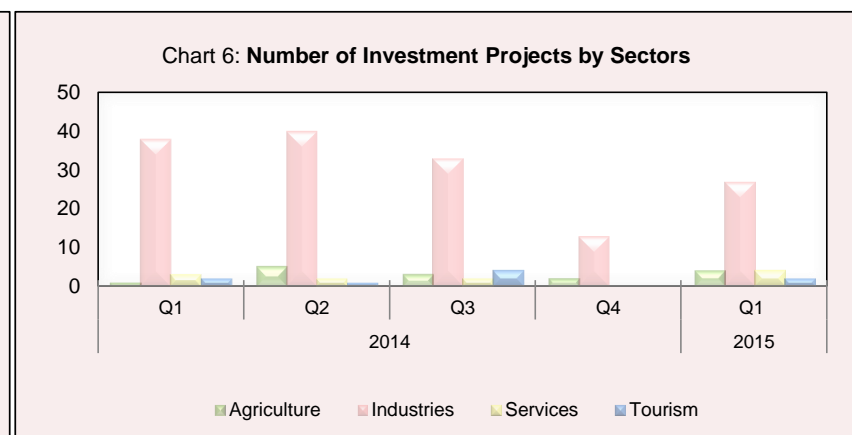
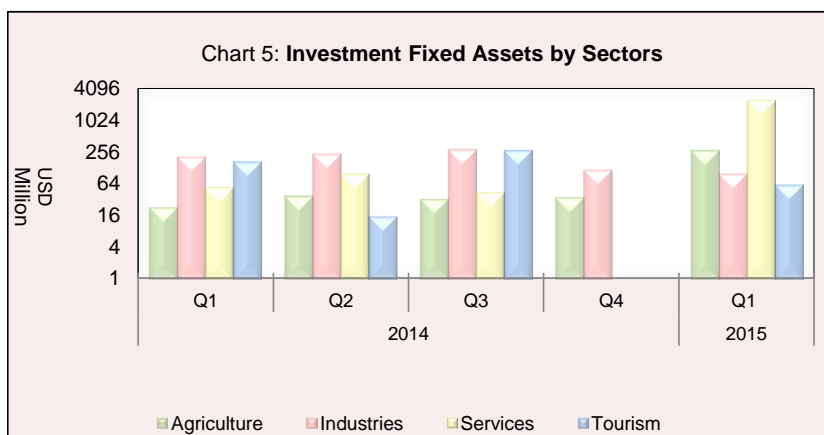

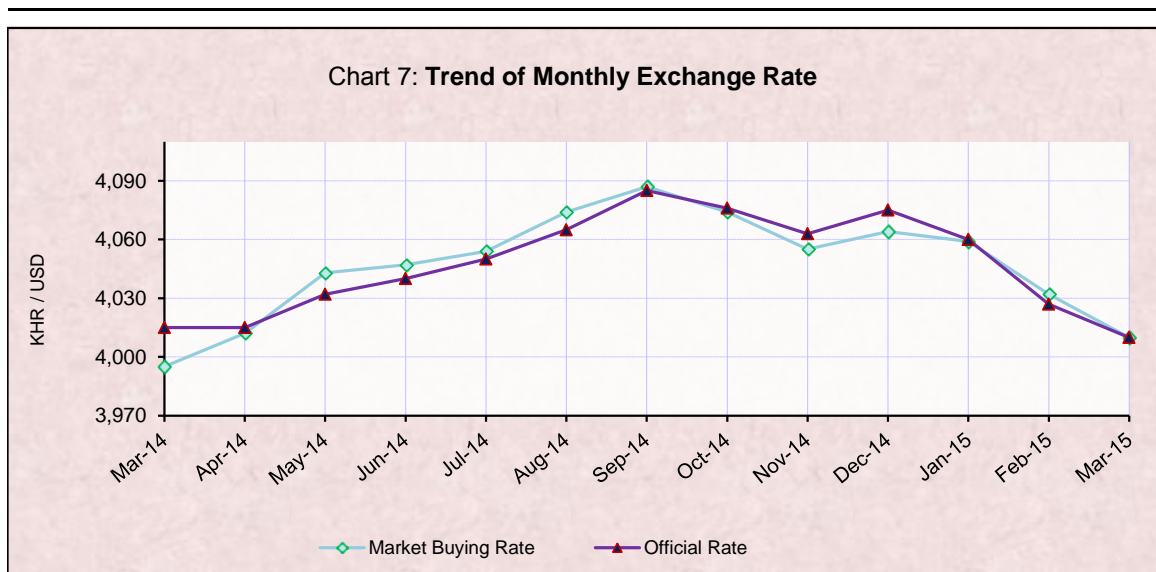

Chart 8: Monetary Survey

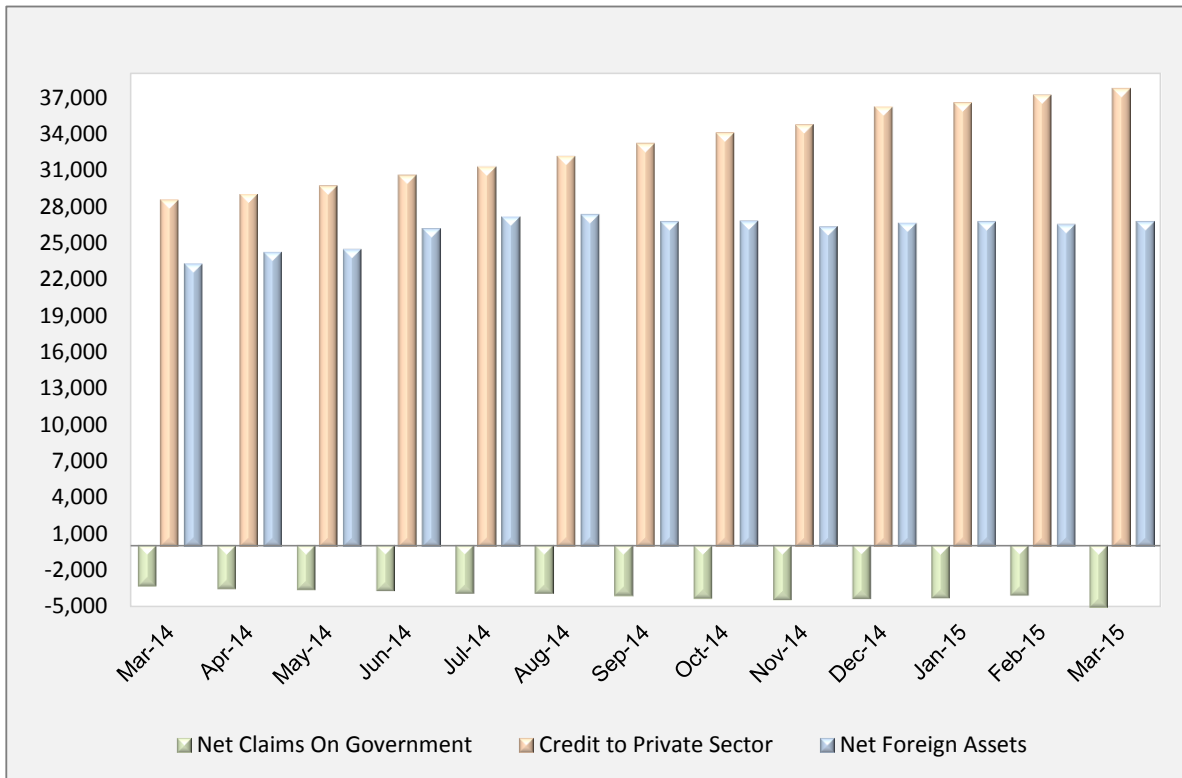


Chart 9: Components of Money Supply

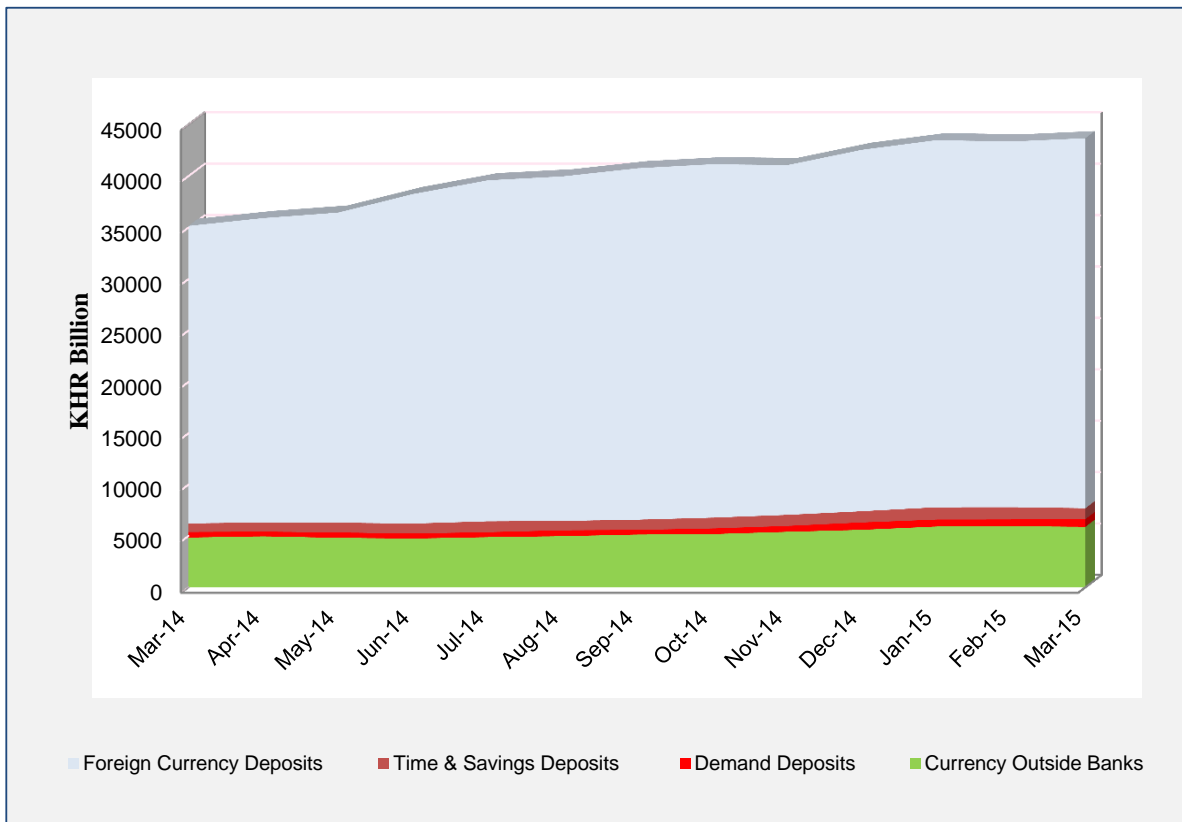

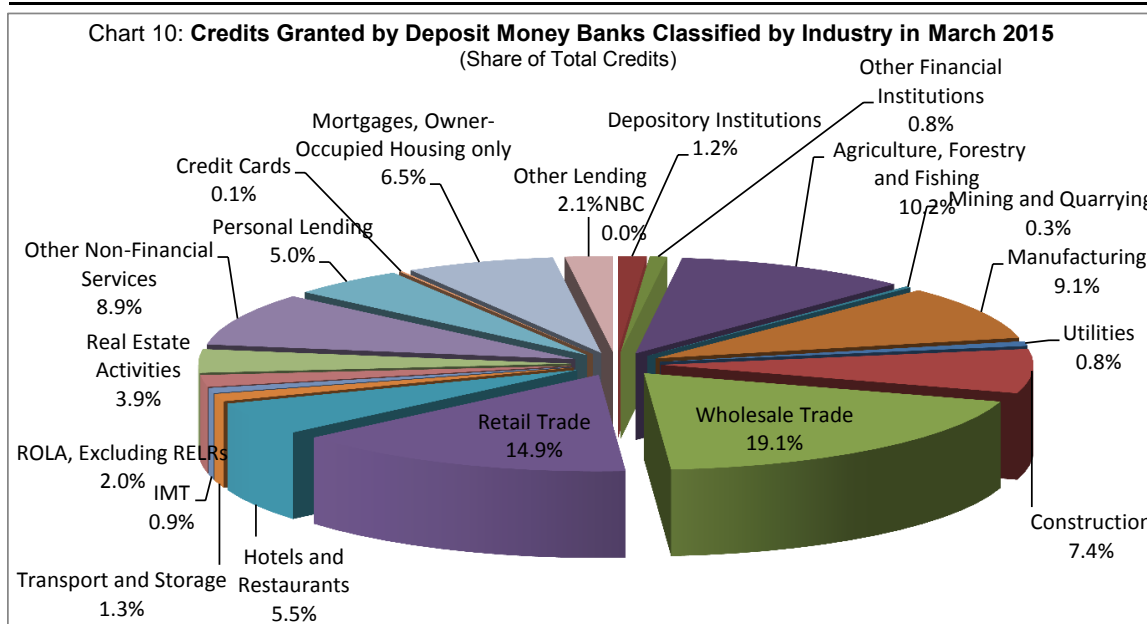

(Share of Grand Total Deposits)

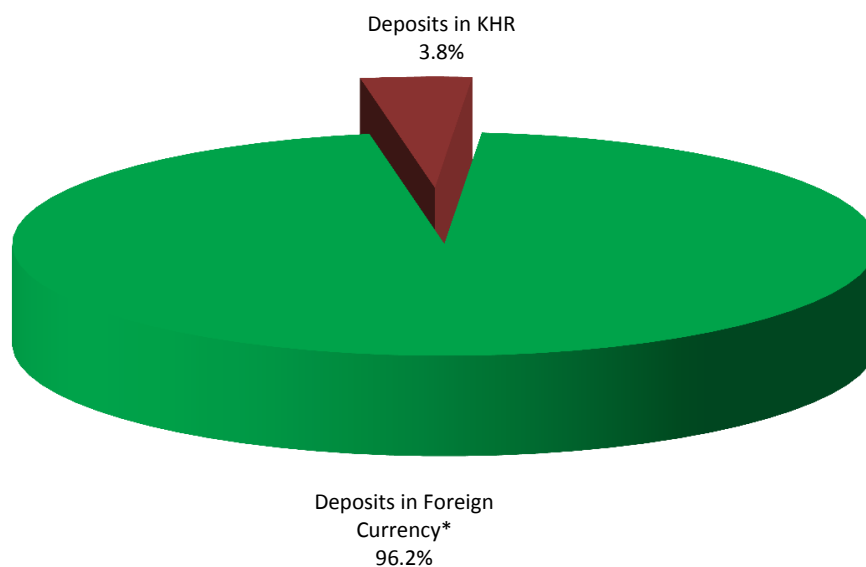

(Share of Total KHR Deposits)

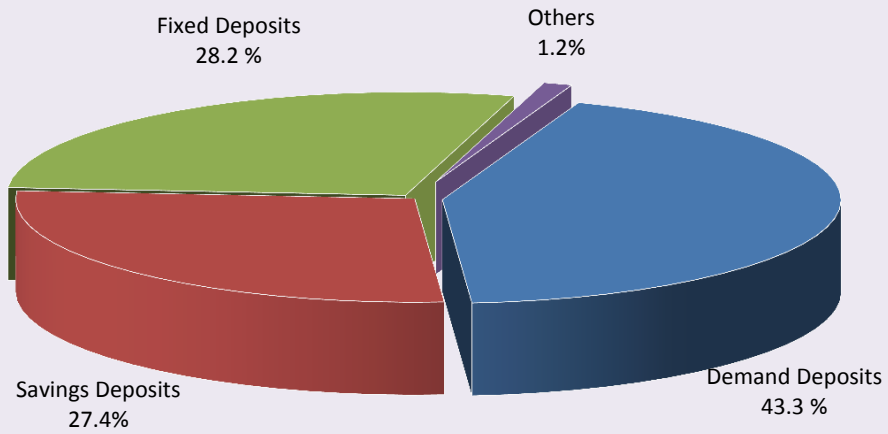
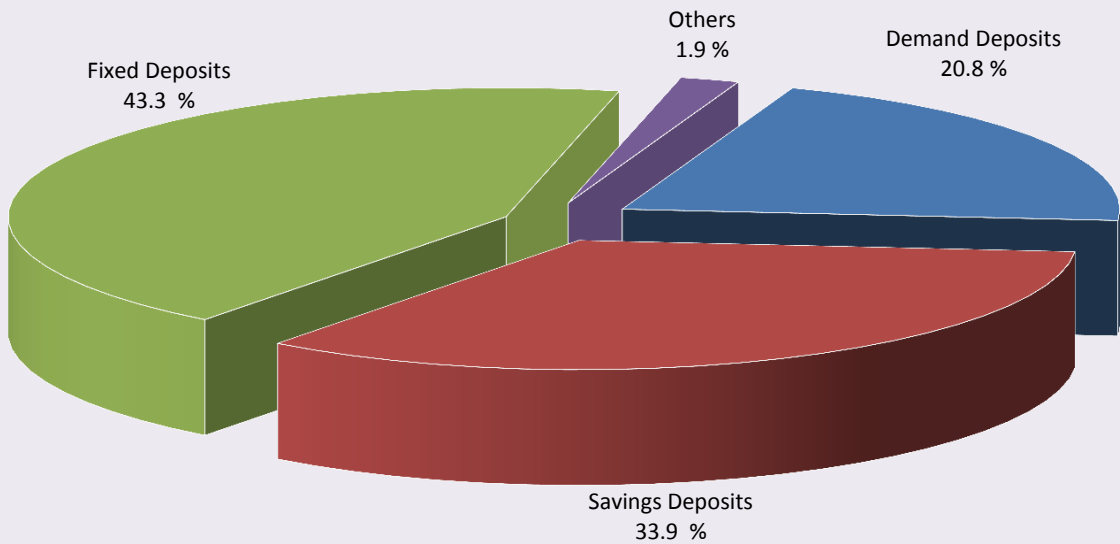


Chart 13: Deposits in Foreign Currency Classified by Type, as of March 2015
